JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Hizma village, stormed several homes, detained five residents including child then withdrew at 03:10. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 21 2015, Israeli forces detained Alaa Al-Qaq (17 years old) after storming his home in Ein Al-Louza area in Silwan neighbourhood and confiscated his cellular telephone. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud gate area in Jerusalem detained Khalil Abu Abbsa (A special needs patient) {A resident of Al-Amari camp in Al-Bireh and Ramallah District}. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Za’im checkpoint detained Amjad Abbassi (a resident of Silwan neighborhood}. (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood detained Mohammad Al-Za’tari. (v) Israeli forces detained five residents: Hamza Kan’an (17 years old), Mohammad Sa’id, Ra’fat Askar, Mahmoud Sa’id and Mus’ab Arafat. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of the Israeli Military and Police officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshiper. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p>
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near “Bet El” settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al until 19:00. (ii) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad. • Raid: At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Silwad until 07:00.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 01:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Hadad Al-Siyahiya village. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:30 on July 21st 2015, Israeli forces raided Jaba’, Silat Al-Thaheir and Sanour village. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village until 22:45. (iii) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Bruqin, fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents as they stormed a home and as a result killed a resident after he was shot in the chest and detained a journalist. (iv) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed and searched a home then detained a resident. • Killing: Israeli forces killed Mohammad Alawneh in Bruqin. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces detained Umniya Amoudi (A resident of Bruqin) as she was visiting her son in Jablou prison. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces positioned near “Salim” Military base detained Ayoub Yaqaba (A resident of Kafr Ra’i) for allegedly carrying a sharp object as he was applying for a Magnetic Identification Card. (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Attiq (A journalist) in Bruqin. (iv) Israeli forces detained Yasser Abu Ja’far in Jenin. • Settler Violence: On July 21st 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area of “Tarsala” settlement (which was previously evacuated) located near Jaba then withdrew later. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: At 08:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 09:30. • Raid: At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 03:30. • Temporary Detention: At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned near Wall Gate (623) located in Deir Al-Ghousoun temporarily detained Muhanad Ghanam (A resident of Deir Al-Ghousoun) then released him at 18:00.

<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village, which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village. (ii) At 19:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (iii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 21st 2015 and again at 03:45 on July 22nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya , detained 2 resident 1 of which was detained after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 05:30. (ii) At 09:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village then stormed and searched a vehicle repair shop. (iii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Jinsafout village. (iv) At 03:40, Israeli forces raided Hajja village, detained a resident after storming and searching his home and confiscated a total amount of 30,000 NIS and gold Jewellery worth 6000 JD. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Nasser Bayda and Amin Al-Hindi in Qalqiliya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Rabe' in Hajja village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 20:45. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita junction until 10:10. (ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Dajjan village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village, stormed and searched several homes, detained three residents and confiscated four hunting rifles and two pistoles and several rounds of bullets then withdrew at 12:45.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 15:40, Israeli forces raided Subustiya village. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Qusra village, stormed and searched 14 homes then withdrew at 04:30. (iv) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Orif village, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:00. (v) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Einbuis village. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Sameh Hammad, Ghannem Ammar and Fayez Al-Qinny. (ii) Israeli forces detained Sharif Al-Safadi in Orif village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Iskaka Village Bridge. (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Deir Istiya until 23:30.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ibrahim Abdel-Raziq (A resident of Tubas) then summoned him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Neve Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' until 11:30. (ii) At 20:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 21:00. (iii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area junction (located at the South entrance of Bethlehem) until 21:00. (iv) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Nihalin village until 22:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Ein Farris area in Nihalin village and conducted military exercises then withdrew at 13:00. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On July 21st 2015, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Fuqin village and served a military order to halt construction of a Football Stadium in Wadi Madiq area located in the south area of the village for allegedly being built without a permit alleging the area is a closed Military zone.

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces detained the child Abed Abu Sbieh (17 years old) near Al-Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron. (ii) At 01:40, Israeli forces detained Ali Shihadeh after storming his home near Al-Shallalat road in the old city of Hebron

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and as a result injured a fisherman.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 01:15, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Al-Maghazi camp.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
