(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:30 and impeded the free

	<p>flow of traffic.</p> <p>(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Hizma village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed a home and summoned Mujahid Abu Rumi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (as they were participating in the funeral of Mahmoud Shawamra who was killed by Israeli forces in Al-ORamas mentioned in the previous report) for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:05, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate opened fire towards Beit Suriq village. (iii) At 23:15, Israeli forces positioned in the area located between Beit Duqq and Ijza villages fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iv) At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (v) At 23:20, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Eisawiya village and Shu'fat camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (vi) At 23:25, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Anas Odwan (a resident of Qalandiya camp). (vii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned the entrance Bir Nabalah fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 04:00, Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Omaaran Abu Khdeir, Abdel-Ra'ouf Abu Khdeir and Tarik Aziz Abu Khdeir in Shu'fat neighbourhood. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Ibbie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh.

(iv) At 03:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya village, detained three residents including two children then withdrew at 04:00. (v) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Amireh in Ni'lin. (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Iz-Al-Din Raji (17 years old), Bara' Abu Shamah (17 years old) and Kamal Salem in Al-Labban Al-Gharbiya village. (iii) Israeli forces detained Walid Badr in Beit Liqya. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:25, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of "Pesagout" settlements located east of Al-Bireh city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 01:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Silwad fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured Salah Hamad (17 years old). (iii) At 01:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning and injured two residents: Rizq Masalmeh and Mohammad Shabanah. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Araba junction, detained a resident, stormed a gas station and confiscated surveillance camera footage then withdrew at 11:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Abu Tahoun (A resident of Tulkarem camp) in Araba. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road

(iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. (iii) At 05:00, Israeli forces closed the steel entrance gate of the Wall located near Jayyus and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area until 12:00. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 14:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 15:50. • Raid:

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Deir Ballut until 23:30. • <u>Detention:</u> At 04:00, Israeli forces detained Samer Abdallah near the entrance of Deir Ballut. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement for Sabbath holiday.

(ii) At 06:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 07:50. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Jericho fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:00 Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Mu'tasim Al-Alawi (A resident of Nablus) as he was returning from Jordan. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:10, an Israeli settler positioned near "Malee Avrim" settlement opened fire towards a vehicle owned by Hussien Musalim (a Resident of Salem village in Nablus and as result damaged his vehicle.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

- (i) At 11:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Nihalin village until 14:05.
- (ii) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 16:20.
- (iii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 23:15.

- **Raid:** At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Betar village and detained a resident.

- **Detention:**

- (i) On July 21st 2014, Israeli forces detained Amir Sa'ed (A resident of Al-Duhisheh camp).
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Abed Mu'amar in Betar village

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces positioned near a checkpoint located in the vicinity of Billal Bin Rabah mosque in Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents and home for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident and injured 7 others including 1 critically injured.
- (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village in Beit Sahur fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 22:25, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khader fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

- **Killing:** Israeli forces killed Mohammad Humarat in Husan village.

- **Wall Construction:**

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Anun junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Dura until 23:45. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, stormed, and searched several homes. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched Aliyan Al-Qawasmeh (A Palestinian Detainee) home then stormed and searched a beauty Salon after blasting open the main entrance then withdrew at 05:00. (iv) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Baqar area in Halhul. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Fuwar junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
