## HEBRON

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
  - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
  - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
  - (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- **Flying Checkpoint:** On the evening of July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar and detained a resident.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At dawn on July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained three residents.
  - (ii) At dawn on July 22<sup>nd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Deir Samit village and detained a University student after storming and searching his home.
  - (iii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya and detained three residents.
  - (iv) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Majd village and detained three residents including a Presidential Guard.
  - (v) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, opened fire as they stormed and searched aa home and as a result killed a resident and Injured Mohammad Abu Mariya and Ahmad Abu Mariya.
- **Killing:** Israeli forces killed Falah Abu Mariya in Beit Ummar.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces detained the child Ahmad Al-Natsheh (14 years old) after storming his home in the old city of Hebron.
