	Closure:  (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and clashed with several residents.
- (ii) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained three residents.

### • Detention:

- (i) On July 23<sup>rd</sup> 2014, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa, Nihad Abu Al-Hawa and Mohammad Abu Al-Hawa in Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Abed Aribi, Karim Za'rour and Foad Hushiyeh.

## • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

## • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks.
- (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1<sup>st</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Ibzie' and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni'meh.
- (v) At 17:50, Israeli forces closed the main entrance leading to Rantis village with Cement blocks then reopened it at 02:00

- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 22:05, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, clashed with several residents and as a result injured Ibrahim Ismail and then withdrew at 00:30.
- (ii) At 03:25, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village.
- <u>Killing:</u> At 20:30, Mohammad Hamarat died of injuries sustained during clashes with Israeli forces in Husan village as mentioned in the previous report.

#### Attack:

- (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned near Dar Salah village in Beit Sahur fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khader fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Rida Shusheh.

## • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May  $1^{\rm st}$  2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces closed the steel gate entrance leading to "Hadgi" settlement in south Hebron.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Hahul and Khursa village until 18:00.

#### **HEBRON**

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, searched several caves then withdrew at 12:00.
- (ii) At 15:25 and again at 02:20, Israeli forces raided Hebron city, detained two residents, stormed, and searched a home.
- (iii)At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Sa'ir and Al-Shuyukh, detained a resident in Al-Shuyukh then withdrew at 05:00.
- (iv)At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained two residents: Salah Al-Nathsheh and Abd Abu Raya in Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Ashraf Al-Haliyah in Al-Shuyoukh.
- (iii)Israeli force detained Mustafa Abdel-Hadi Abu Sharar in Dura.

## • Attack:

- (i) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Fuwar junction fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Oday Al-Titi.
- (iii)At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Urub camp live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv)At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrances Khursa village junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

#### • Settler Violence:

- (i) At 15:10, an Israeli settler stormed and levelled a plot of land in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood on the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) At 15:25, an Israeli settler stormed a home owned by Abdel Khaleq Sadr near Al-Shuhada' road in the old city of Hebron then withdrew under the protection in of Israeli forces at 15:40.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

# ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and

- launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah .Tank Artillery fire target several mosques and Beit Hanoun hospital
- Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 112 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah{which brings up the number of Air strikes since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 4581} and as a result killed 90 residents including 9 children and 8 Women and 3 elderly women and also injured 579 residents including Women and Children,{ which increases the of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 4519 including 1213 Children, 698 Women, and 161 Elderly residents, Israeli airstrikes destroyed 3 mosques in Gaza which increases the amount of mosques destroyed by Israeli airstrikes to 59 including 14 completely destroyed and 45 partially destroyed during the Israeli assault on the Gaza strip.
- Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 130 projectiles.

# NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of critical patients.
