JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On July 24th 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up four checkpoints in Al-Sunah, Ras Al-Amoud, Wadi Al-Juz and Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhoods in Jerusalem and the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:45 on July 23rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Abd Gharbiyeh in during their raid into Abu Dis. (ii) On July 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Malak Al-Suti in Jerusalem. (iii) On the evening of July 24th 2014, detained six residents: Suheil Al-Basti (A security force officer), Adam Hamad, Abdallah Al-Maghrabi, Iz Al-Din Al-Maghrabi, Majed Abu Khdeir and Hakam Hadib in Shu’fat, and Jabal Al-Mukabir town in Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 02:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces closed the main entrance gates leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and prevented several worshipers from entering the mosque to conduct prayers on the night of Qadr (Night of Power) during which Israeli forces rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 21:35, a demonstration took place near Qalandiya checkpoint located at the north entrance of Jerusalem protesting against the Israeli assault on the Gaza strip and calling for the end of the Israeli occupation and declaring that Jerusalem is the capital of Palestine during which Israeli forces fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident and injured 270 residents including 10 children, The Minister of Statistics and 9n others critically injured • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Mohammad Al-Araj near Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Ibzie’ and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni’meh.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. (iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evni Heves” settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:30. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Baqa village until 23:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 07:25 on July 24th 2014, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, detained a resident then withdrew at 07:45. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30, Israeli forces positioned at “Eniv” checkpoint detained Murad Al-Araj (A resident of Anabta). (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Harmishi in Tulkarem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned in west Tulkarem city fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 14 residents and occupied Oday Al-Jallads home and converted it into a military post then withdrew at 02:05.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern

	<p>entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</p> <p>(iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(iv) At 19:50, Israeli forces closed the dirt road leading to the north entrance of Jinsafut with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Immatin village and fired flash grenades into the sky then withdrew at 00:20. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma ’ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 17:00. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 03:20. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:55, Israeli forces raided Nablus, stormed a home and detained two residents. (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, clashed with several residents and as a result injured a resident then withdrew at 02:20. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mustafa Al-Sijil and Mohammad Al-Sijil in Nablus. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces positioned near “Yitsahar” settlement junction and in the vicinity of “Shave Shomron” settlement junction and near Qusra village fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 21 residents including 10 children and an International Peace Activist.

(ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabr camp in Jericho until 02:30. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:20, Israeli forces positioned at the south entrance of Jericho fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the southeastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.

(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' until 01:05. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village until 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 03:25 on July 24th 2014, Israeli forces detained Nassar Najjajrah (15 years old) during their raid into Nihilin. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Husan village fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents who were participating in the funeral of Mohamamd Hamarah (the resident killed by Israeli forces as mentioned in the previous report)for alleged stoning. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou'fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii)At 22:00, Israekli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem; at the entrance of Za'tara, Husan and Al-Khader fired rubber, coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents including a Civil defence officer. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect.
