- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jerusalem

• Attack:

- (i) At dawn on July 25th 2014, Israeli forces positioned in Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during which residents set fire to an Israeli police station protesting Israel's assault on the Gaza strip and as a result injured Ashraf Osiat and assaulted Suheil Al-Basti.
- (ii) At 13:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Eizariya, Abu Dis, Beit Hanina, Jabal Al-Tur, Wadi Al-Juz, and at Qalandiya checkpoint, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and detained four residents in Jabal Al-Tur.
- (iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, the entrances of Anata, Beit Hanina, Budru, Al-Eisawiya, Sur Bahar, Beit Iksa, near Shufat checkpoint, Ras Al-Amoud and Jabal Al-M=ukabir neighbourhoods fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 4 residents and detained a resident.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.

- (iv) At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned at Huewara checkpoint located in south Nablus and at the entrances of Beita, Beit Furiq, Madma and Yatma villages and near "Broga" settlement located in south Nablus fired live ammunition rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 12 residents including 2 children and detained a resident at the entrance of Beit Furiq.

- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located in east Beit Sahur until 01:00.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:00 and again at 23:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Taqou' fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during which Israeli forces occupied Awad Suleiman's home and converted its rooftop into a military post.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured six residents.
- (iii)At 22:25, Israeli forces positioned at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a child and injured five residents.
- <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killedNassir Taqatqa (14 years old) at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sara village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented protesters from reaching the demonstration site.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close

- the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces closed the steel gate entrance leading to "Hadgi" settlement in south Hebron.

• Attack:

- (i) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned the entrance of Beit Ummar fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed 3 residents and injured 5 others including Mohammad Owed critically injured.
- (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar, near Al-Huwar junction and Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed a resident and injured five others including a child.
- (iii)At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result killed 3 residents and injured 13 others

Killing:

- (i) Israeli forces killed three residents: Hisham Abu Mariya, Sultan Al-Za'aqiq and Abdel-Hamid Baraghit in Beit Ummar.
- (ii) Israeli forces killed Eid Fadaliya in Al-Urub camp.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 01:40, Israeli settlers assaulted and injured 2 residents: Mohammad Muqtan and Mohammad Fattfah (Both residents of Tarqumiya)
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to On November 14th 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah .Tank Artillery fire target several mosques and Beit Hanoun hospital Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 155 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed **56** residents including **9** children, 8 **ALL** Women and 2 Paramedics { which increases the number of civilians killed to 975 DISTRICTS including 208 children and 109 Women since the Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip Women resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza raised to 5840 including **1693 Children, 1360 Women,** Israeli airstrikes destroyed 325 homes including 30 completely destroyed and 293 partially destroyed the number of homes destroyed by Israeli airstrikes to 5154 including 726 completely destroyed and 4426 partially destroyed during the Israeli assault on the Gaza strip and destroyed 5 mosques in Gaza which increases the amount of mosques destroyed by Israeli airstrikes to 67 including 15 completely destroyed and 51 partially destroyed during the Israeli assault on the Gaza strip. Israeli airstrikes targeted 15 hospitals, 145 schools and 4 Universities since the Israeli assault on Gaza. Israeli assault on Gaza forces more than 187000 residents to flee their homes.

Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching 70 projectiles.
