JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 00:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Duqqu village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:40, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning during which residents set fire to an Israeli police station protesting Israel’s assault on the Gaza strip and as a result injured Nabil Majid Al-Rajabi. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Abu Dis, the entrances of Anata , Beit Hanina, Budru, Al-Eisawiya, near Shufat checkpoint, Shu’fat Ras Al-Amoud and Al-Tur neighbourhoods fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Rif’at Zidan Darwish (A resident of Hebron). • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces detained Mahdi Faraj Atwan in Sur Bahar village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Thurba Kamal Tabi’ Taha (A resident of Beit Illo village) for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier. (iii) At 23:50, Israeli forces detained Shu’ayeb Bassam Al-Natsheh in Beit Hanina. • <u>Expulsion:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Fadi Bakir (A guard at Al-Aqsa mosque compound then released him after handing him a military expulsion order preventing him from entering Al-Aqsa mosque compound for a period of three months. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 08:00, Israeli settlers assaulted and injured Amir Mazen Abu Eisheh (a resident of Beit Hanina) leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the northeast entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) Since 02:25 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp with Cement blocks. (iv) Since 16:15 on July 1st 2014, Israeli forces closed the main roads connecting Deir Izbie’ and Ras Kara Kar and Kafr Ni’meh.

(ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Mohamad Bassan Shabbanah.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Far’a village, temporarily detained two residents: Mohammad Khaled Bani Odeh and Fairs Khalid Bani Odeh then released them at 03:50.

(iii) At 09:40, Israeli forces closed a detour road leading to agricultural land near “Evni Heves” settlement. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00 and again at 21:10, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 01:40. • <u>Attack:</u> .At 22:45, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Zeita fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 13:50 on July 11th 2014, Israeli forces closed the east entrance of Jinsafut village with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 01:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 03:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 20:15, Israeli Forces raided the town of Jayyous. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:50, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Yazid Wael Swidan leaving hospitalised with contusions.

	<p>(ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces positioned near the east entrance of Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and injured the child: Amer Zaher Abu Hammad (15 years old) after he was assaulted by Israeli forces.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Yitsahar” settlement. (ii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarrah village junction until 00:30. • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:25, Israeli forces raided Huwara until 21:50. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40 and again at 23:15, Israeli forces positioned at Huwara checkpoint located in south Nablus fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces positioned at Huewara checkpoint located in south Nablus and at the entrance of Beit Furiq, fired live ammunition rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. (iv) At 12:00, Israeli forces closed the west entrance gate leading to Kafr Al-Dik with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Marda village until 23:30. (ii) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:40.

(ii) At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Oja village until 23:20.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou' until 00:40. 	<p>Fajjar.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Al-Deir village, occupied Adnan Ahmad Hajjajeh's home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 00:50. (ii) At 21:35, Israeli forces raided Husan village, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 01:10. (iii) At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar until 00:30 • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:35, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Husan village' fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned near Billal Bin Rabah mosque located in North Bethlehem, fired rubber coated steel bullets stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Iz-Aldin Mohammad Izzat Shaqarneh (A resident of Nihalin). • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 01:00, Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Irtas village and levelled a plot of land then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces closed the steel gate entrance leading to "Hadgi" settlement in south Hebron. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ljilat Al-Miyah village located in east Yatta. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp then stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, stormed a home, and damaged two vehicles owned by Saber Abu Ayyash and Ahmad Abu Ayash. (iii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and detained a resident.

(iii) Israeli forces detained Fadi Bassam Abu Zied and Ehab Abed Irmalat in Bani Na'im. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned the entrance of Al-Urub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were participating in the funeral of Eid Rabah Abdel Qadder Ifdiliyat who was killed by Israeli forces as mentioned in the previous report) for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child Mohammad Yusef Madi Jawarat (16 years old). (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned near Halhul bridge fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 22:55, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Zif village fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents. (iv) At 23:50, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Einun village junction fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured a resident. (v) At 02:10, Israeli forces positioned at Khursa village junction fired, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
