#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and closed the checkpoint at 01:20 and impeded the free flow of traffic until 04:05.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed and searched several homes, detained two residents including a child then withdrew at 05:50.

#### • Detention:

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained eight residents: Mohammed Joulani, Hossam Sidr, Ayman al-Dweik, Alaa Marra, Tariq al-Tamimi, Tariq Salameh, Munir Nimr, and Amjad Azzuf.
- (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shu'fat neighbourhood detained six resident: Mohammed Abed, Mohamed Abdel Abu Khudair, Rashid Abu Dawood Khudair, and Samih Sami Awadallah, Abdullah Abu Ayyub al-Khudair, and Uday Al-Khudair.
- (iii) Israeli forces positioned at Al-Eizariya detained Anas Busa (17 years old) and Abdallah Basa.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) At 15:15, Israeli forces closed the steel gate entrance leading to "Hadgi" settlement in south Hebron.

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

(i) At dawn on July 27<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed a home,

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. Later on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease-fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by raiding and opening fire and launching tank Artillery shells towards North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah .Tank Artillery fire target several mosques and Beit Hanoun hospital
- Israeli fighter jets broke the cease fire agreement by launching missiles in 155 consecutive strikes towards Palestinian gunmen in North Gaza, Gaza, Central Gaza Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result killed 15 residents including Women and a child { which increases the number of civilians killed to 1035 including 236 children and 93 Women since the Israeli assault on the Gaza Strip Women and also injured 393 residents including Women and Children, { which increases the of resident injured since the Israeli Attack on Gaza to 6233 including 1994 Children, 1169 Women.
- Palestinian Gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by launching **58** projectiles.
