WEST BANK

Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At dawn on July 28th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, stormed several homes and detained six children.

• Detention:

- (i) At 06:40 on July 27th 2015, Israeli forced detained Nader Thiyab during their raid into Qalandiya camp as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Assaliya in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained six residents: Yahya Darbus (14 years old), Hani Nasser (14 years old), Adam Mahmoud (14 years old), Mohammad Mazour (15 years old), Mohammad Obied (14 years old) and Majd Mustafa (14 years old) in Al-Eisawiya village.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Salaslah Gate (A Main gate entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) temporarily detained Hiba Al-Hussieni then released her later.

Attack:

(i) At 15:45, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya Checkpoint fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured four residents including a child: Ammar Al-Ghalban (16 years old), Mohammad Barahmeh, Hazem Abdallah and Jihad Judeh.

	 (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	• <u>Home Demolition:</u> On the morning of July 28 th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Ain Al-Louza, Ain Al-Foqa area's in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and demolished a home (consisting of 2 rooms) owned by Eyad Al-Abbassi for allegedly being built without a licence and also demolished an apartment (under
	construction) and 2 merchant shops owned by Khalil Mohammad for allegedly being built without a licence.
	 Assault on Places of Worship: At 08:30, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police Officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.
	• <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 22:00, 2 Israeli settlers assaulted Mohammad Barakat (A Bus Driver) and sprayed his face with Pepper spray and as a result left him hospitalised with severe burn to the eyes and upper body.
	• Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu
	Dis town.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross,
	after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

Raid: (i) At 09:00 and again at 01:40, Israeli forces raided Shweikiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem and stormed a home.

QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds Raid: At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth, stormed 2 homes and detained a resident Detention: Israeli forces detained Abdallah Zahran in Kafr Thulth. 	 Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem;
	the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and
	 Qaryut. Flying Checkpoint: At 21:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Huwara, temporally detained several residents then released them after questioning. Raid: (i) At 03:00 on July 27th 2015, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Qibliya and detained a resident.

	• Settler Violence: At 03:35, Israeli settlers riding in eight vehicles stormed Nablus
	and attempted to storm Joseph's Tomb area during which Palestinian Police forces

	roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city

	(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30 th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to

	• Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and
	impeded the free flow of traffic.
	• Flying Checkpoint:
	(i) At 23:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Bruqin
	until 02:00.
	(ii) At 01:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint in the area between Yasuf and
	Iskaka villages until 02:10.
JERICHO	<u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set
	up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement, the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' until 11:35
- (ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Husan village.
- (iii) At 20:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 20:55
- (iv) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 21:15.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Taqou' and stormed 3 homes.
- (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed and searched several homes, detained 3 residents and summoned Sameer Al-Akhras (A resident of Al-Duhisheh Camp) to report to Israeli Intelligent for questioning then withdrew at 06:30.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ahmad Ta'amrah, Mohammad Qawazbah and Moath Ta'amra in Bethlehem.
- Settler Violence: At 13:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed land located between Nihalin and Al-Jab'a villages then withdrew at 15:20.

BETHLEHEM

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 15:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar until 16:50.
- Raid: At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp, clashed with several residents as the stormed a home and detained a resident.

Detention:

- At 00:45, Israeli forces detained two residents: Rami Al-Awawi and Yusef Al-Junaydi during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 10:50, Israeli forces detained Hannan Narwikh (A resident of Hebron) as she was visiting her brother in Al-Ramla prison.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ishaq Al-Khatib in Al-Fuwar camp.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement after raiding and opening fire towards
 Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA

• <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
