WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

• Raid:

- (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and clashed with several residents.
- (ii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Hizma village and detained two residents.

• Detention:

- (i) At dawn on July 28th 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents including four children: Muneer Dari (14 years old), Mohammad Al-Hindi (15 years old), Oday Dari (15 years old) and Ashraf Obied during their raid into Al-Eisawiya as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained the child Aboud Al-Haddad (14 years old) in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Issa Subuh and Islam Subuh in Hizma village.

• Attack:

- (i) At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Eisawiya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Assault on Places of Worship: At 10:50, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police Officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshipers.

• Wall Gates:

(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu

	(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet El" settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 22:30. Raid: At dawn on July 28th 2015, Israeli forces raided Khirbithat Al-Misbah village and detained two residents. Detention: Israeli forces detained two residents: Mohammad Harfoush and Oday Darah in Khirbithat Al-Misbah village. Attack: At 19:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. Settler Violence: At 19:30, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over the child Ali Al-Masri (14 years old) along the main raid near Rantis village and as a result, left him hearticlised with contraining.

JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Settler Violence: On the evening of July 27th 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area where "San-Ur" settlement once stood in Jenin and are currently still in the area. Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	• <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:10 and at 15:10 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 06:00.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds Flying Checkpoint: At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 13:15. Raid: At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Ras Attiya village until 13:20. Temporary Detention: At 20:45, Israeli forces temporarily detained Muntasir Ahmad (A resident of Azzun Atma) then released him later. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the

	• Checkpoint: At 10:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwwara
	checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	• <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint temporarily detained Billal Salah (A resident of Kafr Dan village in Jenin) then released him later.
JERICHO	• <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District until 16:50.
BETHLEHEM	
	(v) At 20:50, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- Raid: At dawn on July 28th 20915, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained three residents: Nasser Jaber, Bara' Jaber and Ismail Jaber in Jaber neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (ii) Israeli forces detainedAbdel-Fattah Al-Halaqiya in Al-Shiyoukh.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement after raiding and opening fire towards Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- Attack: At 06:30 on July 28th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of AL-Sudaniya beach located in West Beit Lahiya.
