<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Barid neighbourhood Circle in Al-Ram.</li> <li>(ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Al-Ram.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents and detained three children.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained five residents including a child: Omar Abu Ziena (15 years old), Isam Ashour, Omar Abbassi, Baker Abbassi and Hazem Al-Sa’iri.</li> <li>(ii) On the evening of July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Za’im checkpoint located at the east entrance of Jerusalem detained Baha Abu Al-Hawa (A resident of Al-Tur neighbourhood) and assaulted him.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Ameer Mahmoud (17 years old), Mohammad Al-Kiswani (17 years old) and Majd Nasser (17 years old) in Al-Iswawiya village.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu'fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Destruction of Property:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 07:00 on July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces stormed the Industrial zone "Atrout" located in North Jerusalem and demolished a building owned by Al-Shams Gas.</li> <li>(ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Al-Dam area in Beit Hanina and demolished a Reception Hall owned by Akram Abu Shalbak, a barracks owned by Ghazi Yassin, a carpentry shop owned by Omar Taha and construction supply shop for allegedly being built without a licence.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 08:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police Officers stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 01:00, a group of Israeli settlers positioned in Jerusalem assaulted Mohammad Sab Al-Labban (A resident of Al-Ram) as he was travelling to Jerusalem.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafir Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>(ii) At 21:40 on June 30<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet El" settlement leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 11:20, Israeli forces closed Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Beit El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh and impeded the free flow of traffic until 18:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Taybeh junction (located along the main road connecting Ramallah and Jericho).</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city until 10:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settlement Activity:</u></b> On July 19<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli Authorities approved the construction of 300 new settlement units in "Bet El" settlement located in North Al-Bireh city on Palestinian owned land occupied in 1967.</li> </ul>
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Road:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> Since the evening of July 27<sup>th</sup> 2015, a group of Israeli settlers stormed the area where "San-Ur" settlement once stood in Jenin and stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road connecting Jenin and Nablus during which they withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces on the evening of July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015.</li> </ul>

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 02:35 on July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid.</li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> On July 28<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Sayah (A resident of Quffin) as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning based on a prior summons.</li> </ul>
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak of the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jet junction and impeded the free flow of traffic travelling along the bypass road leading to "Yitsahar" settlement in North Huwara in Nablus.</li> <li>(ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Qaddumin" settlement until 24:00.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Azzun and detained two residents.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:10, Israeli forces raided Jet village, ordered the local village council to halt construction on an agricultural road located in western area of the village then withdrew at 11:35.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Isalim and Samir Shabtiya in Azzun.</li> <li>• <b>Destruction of Property:</b> At 16:00, Israeli forces levelled a plot of land in Al-Jit village and destroyed an agricultural road in the west area of the village.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun' Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure of 500 dunums of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</li> </ol> </li> </ul>

NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> At 23:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 02:35.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 10:20 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Dajjan village junction until 21:10.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Shave Shomron" settlement junction until 13:25.</li> <li>(iii) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at "Yitsahar" settlement junction located in North Huwara and impeded the free flow of traffic towards the road leading to Jet village in Qalqiliya.</li> <li>(iv) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 21:10.</li> <li>(v) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beita junction until 21:50.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 19:35, Israeli forces raided Burqa village until 20:15.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Iraq Burin village, stormed and searched five homes then withdrew at 02:15.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Detention:</b> At 15:15, Israeli forces detained Abdel-Majid Abu Shihadeh (A resident of Orif village) after chasing him as he was driving his vehicle near Burin village junction.</li> <li>• <b>Settler Violence:</b> At 15:00, an Israeli settler riding on a motorcycle stormed Burin village and set fire to agricultural land near "Baraja" settlement.</li> </ul>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> At 00:25, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic 00:55.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Iskaka village.</li> </ul>
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</li> <li>• <b>Temporary Detention:</b> At 12:00 on July 25<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Diya Shawahneh as he was returning from Jordan and confiscated 500 JD then released him after questioning by Israeli intelligence officers at 17:00.</li> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqbat Al-Jaber and Ain Al-Sultan camps, clashed with several residents as they stormed two homes until 04:40.</li> </ul>

**BETHLEHEM**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
  - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Joss ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Neve Daniele" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
  - (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
  - (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
  - (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
  - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
  - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
  - (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahour until 12:00.
  - (ii) At 14:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khader Bridge until 16:00.
  - (iii) At 14:45 and again at 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Taqou' until 20:50.
  - (iv) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Marah Rabbah village until 17:45.
  - (v) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Taqou', clashed with several residents then withdrew at 21:20.
  - (vi) At 22:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement junction, temporarily detained two residents: Majed Attah and Muhanad Amarneh (Both residents of Jenin) then released them later.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 23:15 on July 28<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, Beit Sahour and Al-Doha, stormed and searched a home, detained five residents and confiscated three hunting Rifles.
  - (ii) At 23:55, Israeli forces on July 29<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 04:00.

- (iii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village stormed and photographed a home.
- (iv) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem, detained 3 residents including a child then withdrew at 04:00.
- (v) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed and searched several homes; summoned Izzat Dieriya to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:30.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained five residents: Nasri Ayash, Nidal Ayash, Mohammad Hantash, Ziyad Hantash and Iliyas Ghaltash during their raid into raided Bethlehem, Beit Sahour and Al-Doha.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained three residents: Sabri Darwish Sabri (17 years old), Mus'ab Thiyab and Atoya Abu Aker during their raid into Al-Ayda camp.

<p><b>HEBRON</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta.
