• <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 19:45, Israeli forces stormed Khilat Al-Fahem area in Al-Khader and confiscated a Bulldoser and temporarily detained three residents: Nader Salah, Eyad Salam and Mohammad Salah then released them after summoning them to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
• <u>Assault on Property:</u> On July 30 th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Bariya area in Taqou' and served military orders to halt rehabilitation work on 14 homes in the area and confiscated construction tools.

	• <u>Closure:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold
	market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi
	neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-
	Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market
	also remains closed.
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green
	Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli
	army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
	<u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the
	old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour
	roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement after raiding and opening fire towards Gaza. Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
