JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Biddu until 21:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Mahdi Al-Abbassi in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained Taha Abu Ali in the old city of Jerusalem. (iii) At 22:00, Israeli forces detained Ramzi Oweisat in Jerusalem. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 12:30, Israeli force stormed Beit Hanina and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Islam Abu Irmeleh for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of

	<p>Rantis village until 12:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:00 on May 31st 2015, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, summoned two residents: Hazim Al-Bari'at and Raed Al-Bari'at to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Mazra'a Al-Sharqiya and stormed a Cellular telephone shop.\ (iii) At 12:05, Israeli forces raided Deir Ijrier village. (iv) At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazoun camp, stormed two homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:35. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Jamil Shawamrah in Al-Jalazoun camp.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Ti'inik village, demolished several Green House and served a military order for the demolition of a water well owned by Suliman Al-Ziyoud for allegedly being built without a licence. (ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Jaba'then stormed and searched a home. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Jalqamous village until 05:00. (iv) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Adnan Al-Atrash in Jenin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayassir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Khirbiet Attouf village until 21:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:15, Israeli forces raided the area between Tamoun and Khirbeit Attuf.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 12:05, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> At 18:40, Israeli forces closed wall gate (708) located in Far'oun village then reopened it at 18:55.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:45, Israeli forces raided Immatin and Far'ata villages. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village until 02:45. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 12:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic and prevented residents from leaving the area until 13:20. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Aqraba until 10:00. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up 5 checkpoints at the entrance of Beit Furiq, between Nablus and Assirah Al-Shimaliya, along Al-Bithan road located at the east entrance of Nablus, and at the entrance of Tel village then prevented residents from leaving the area until 13:20. (iii) At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Tel village junction and detained a resident. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00 and 21:25, Israeli forces raided Huwara, occupied Mustafa Ali’s Home and converted its rooftop into a Military post then withdrew at 23:10. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ibba until 13:30. (iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Sarah village until 02:15. (iv) At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balata camp, detained 2 residents including a journalist after storming their homes in the camp then withdrew at 04:40. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Sameh Ramadan near Tel village junction. (ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Al-Beitawi (A journalist) and Mohammad Hijazi during their raid into Nablus and Balata camp. • Settlement Activity: On May 31st 2015, Israeli forces paved a 150-settlement road in Al-Barjamiya area located in east Assirah Al-Qibliya which connects a Military post with a water tank used by village residents.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 12:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:20

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Ballout until 13:00. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 09:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained four residents: Mti⁷ Suliman, Ahmad Suliman, Marwan Aqel and Jallal Salman at Za'tara checkpoint junction then released them at 10:15.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction until 22:15. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the South entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> At 09:55, Israeli forces raided Jericho, served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Jamal Abu Jarrar then withdrew at 10:10. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 23:30, Israeli settlers positioned near "Ni'meh" settlement stoned residents and vehicles travelling along road (90).
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> On May 31st 2015, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Beit Sahur, assaulted Ahmad Salaah (A resident of Al-Khader)

	<p>and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou' until 23:00. (ii) At 07:15, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained three children. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three children: Mohammad Za'oul (14 years old), Mohammad Hamar (14 years old) and Mohammad Shusheh (14 years old) in Husan village.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home and summoned Shihab Al-Jindi to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou'. • <u>Detention:</u> At 13:30, Israeli forces detained two children: Fathi Mahfouth (17 years old) and Omar Al-Bidawi (14 years old) and temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Bidawi then released him at 14:00.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza, Central Gaza and Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Closure of Crossing Points: (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Attack: At 09:20, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers on their agricultural land located in Jahr Al-Dik in south east Gaza.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the morning of May 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers on their agricultural land located in east Wadi Al-Salqa located in east Deir Al-Balah.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the morning of May 31st 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers on their agricultural land located in east Al-Fakhari.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
