| <b>JERUSALEM</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to Jerusalem city and to prevent civilians from other Palestinian districts from entering the city, only allowing access to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding Jerusalem city and restrict access to the area to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba’.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section, separating the area of Dahiyat al Bareed from the town of Ar Ram.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and force civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Checkpoint:</b> The Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designates a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoint/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:</b> At 13:55, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction to Ma’ale Adumim settlement, searched civilians and vehicles, detained a Palestinian Police vehicle, and allowed to cross at a later time.</li> <li>• <b>Detentions:</b> On 01 June 2011, the Israeli army detained two female journalists in the old city of Jerusalem: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Muna al Qawasmi; and</li> <li>(ii) Maysa’ Abu Ghazaleh.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Attack on Religious Site:</b> In the morning of 01 June 2011, a group of Israeli settlers raided, under protection of Israeli troops, the grounds of the Al Aqsa Mosque compound and provoked civilians inside the mosque.</li> <li>• <b>Settler Violence:</b> On 01 June 2011, a group of Israeli settlers attacked with sharp tools and iron bars a number of civilians in the old city of Jerusalem, leaving three civilians with injuries and contusions.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |

| QALQILYA | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure of Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:05, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to ‘Azzun town and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to Jit village and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(iii) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between Jayyus town and Kafr Jammal village and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Injury:</b> At 13:00, an Israeli army jeep ran over Tawfiq Abu Hamed near the gate to Tsufin settlement, leaving him with injuries and contusions. Abu Hamed was transported to an Israeli hospital for medical treatment.</li> <li>• <b>Raid/Detentions:</b> At 14:00, the Israeli army raided Qalqiliya city and searched a building after detaining residents outside.</li> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On 30 May 2011, Israeli troops positioned at Jaljuliya checkpoint arrested Mohammed Halawah Sweilem.</li> <li>(ii) At 01:20 on 01 June 2011, the Israeli army arrested 17-year-old Mustafa Bilal ‘Umran during its raid into ‘Azzun town, in addition to those report yesterday.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Wall Gates:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi ar Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the iron gate at the entrance to the village of Ras ‘Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> |
