JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	<p>(ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya and detained 3 residents. (ii) At 22:50, Israeli forces raided Hizma village demolished 5 Barracks owned by Khaled Al-Khatib, Mohammad Al-Sini, Jawad Al-Khatib, and Mohammad Al-Khatib for allegedly being built without licences then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Wad road in the old city of Jerusalem fired tear gas grenades and assaulted several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 3 residents including 2 children: Nur Al-Zurba (3 years old), Khaled Barghouth (13 years old) and Yasser Najib leaving them hospitalised . (ii) At 21:45, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning as they stormed the neighbourhood and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ayoub AbuA ssab, Daoud Atiyeh and Mohammad Abu Al-Humous in Al-Isawiya village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Sameh Sarhan in Silwan neighbourhood. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> on the 1st of June, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On the morning of June 2nd 2014, Israeli forces stormed Al-Sheikh area in Jabal Al-Zaytouneh neighbourhood and demolished concrete fences surrounding a parking lot owned by Asslan family and demolished a livestock barracks and a storage room owned by Akram Qanbar for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 18:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli Prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jaba' until 09:40. (ii) At 09:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Al-Silat Al-Thahr until 12:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Anza village, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child: Hamza Sharabati (14 years old) then withdrew at 11:25. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village, clashed with several residents and again at 16:55 and for a second time clashed with several residents. (iii) At 12:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Zababida village set up a checkpoint near the Arab –American University then withdrew at 13:55. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road which connects Tulkarem and Qalqiliya until 10:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:15 and again at 01:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:00 Israeli forces detained Mo'ayad Amar, a resident of Al-Jarushiya village as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
