JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Eizariya. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On May 31st 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Yunis Jahalin and Salameh Jahalin in Al-Eizariya. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained the child Mohammad Al-Abbassi (15 years old) in Silwan neighbourhood as he was heading to school. (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Jihad Ghayous and Daoud Sbitan in Al-Tur neighbourhood. (iv) At 13:30, Israeli forces detained Omar Idris (A resident of Dahiyat Al-Bareed) as he was reporting to Israeli Intelligence for questioning based on a prior summon. (v) At 23:20, Israeli forces detained Mu’taz Halaqiya (A resident of Al-Eisawiya) in Beit Hanina. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Shayah neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for allegedly stoning. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Qaddum area in Silwan fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for allegedly stoning then stormed and searched a local mosque in the area. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:30, Israeli forces stormed Silwan neighbourhood and demolished 2 apartment (each 70 m²) owned by Iz Khaled and Hisham Khaled for allegedly being built without a licence during which they clashed with several residents who attempted to prevent the demolitions and as a result injured 3 residents”: Hisham Abu Khaled, Nur Al-Din Abu Khaled and Iz Al-Din Abu Khaled after assaulting them and left Fatimah Abu Khaled (70 years old) suffocated from tear gas inhalation.

	<p>(ii) At 06:00, Israeli forces stormed Salah Al-Din road in Jerusalem and demolished a home (140 m²) owned by Rafeeq Salameh for allegedly being built without a licence.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At dawn on June 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed and searched a home after detonating the main entrance gate and damaged home furniture. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Bara Hamad in Silwad. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near “Pesagout” settlement located in the east area of Al-Bireh city, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes, detained 2 residents including a child then withdrew at 04:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on June 1st 2015, Israeli forces detained two residents: Amin Kan’an and Tariq Abu Al-Hija during their raid into Jenin. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaled Abu Ziena and Riyadh Abu Ziena (17 years old) in Jenin camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Home Demolition:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces stormed Khirbeit Al-Ras village and Ein Al-Hilweh area in the North Jordan valley and served 2 military orders for the demolition of a tent and a livestock den owned by Mohammad Bani Odeh (a resident of Khirbet Ras Al-Ahmar) and Adel Daraghmeh (A resident of Ein Al-Hilweh area in the North Jordan valley) to be implemented in 3 days.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 15:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:15.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

	<p>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 20:00. (ii) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Qussin village junction until 21:35. (iii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Burqa village and prevented residents from entering or exiting the village until 21:50. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 1st 2015, Israeli forces raided Burin village and detained a resident. (ii) At 10:05, Israeli forces raided Talfit village until 10:30. (iii) At 10:10, Israeli forces raided Huwara until 11:50. (iv) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus, clashed with several residents and as a result injured the child Omran Massimi (17 years old) and temporarily detained Yasser Obied and several of his family members and released them later then withdrew at 04:00. (v) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya until 01:45. (vi) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Nussayrah village stormed and searched a home and summoned Assir Al-Mahher to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hamdan Eid in Burin village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:45, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Shilo settlement opened a closed road, which connects the settlement with Qaryout village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 08:00 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:10. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Iskaka Village Bridge. (ii) At 18:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Deir Istiya until 21:45.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the South entrance of Jericho, temporarily detained five Security Force officers then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces raided Jericho until 09:45. (ii) At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Oja village then stormed and searched a home. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Ein Al-Sultan camp, stormed and searched several homes, detained three residents in the camp then withdrew at 03:45. • Detention: Israeli forces detained three residents: Samer Al-Sarafandi, Jihad Manasrah and Yazan Abu Lawal.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 22:05. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar until 22:05. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched a home and again at 20:00 searched several other homes. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 00:20. (iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh until 04:20. • <u>Detention:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces detained the child Mohammad Al-Razam (17 years old) in the old city of Hebron.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and as a result injured three Fishermen and also detained five fishermen including a child.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of West Beit Lahiya, detained 5 fisherman including a child (All residents of Al-Shata') and confiscated their fishing boat. (ii) On the morning of June 2nd 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of West Beit Lahiya, and as a result injured three fishermen. • Detention: Israeli forces detained five fishermen: Ibrahim Al-Najjar (14 years old), Rami Al-Najjar, Mohammad Al-Najjar, Adel Abu Rayaleh and Yusef Abu Rayaleh off the shores off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of West Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
