JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of a tunnel leading to Bir Nabala. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Anata junction. (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Khan Al-Hamra area and detained a resident. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram, stormed and searched a car wash and detained a resident. (ii) On June 2nd 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya and detained two residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained five residents: Murad Shweiki, Bassam Shweiki, Naseem Shweiki, Basel Shweiki and Waleed Firawi in the old city of Jerusalem. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Iksa checkpoint detained Jarbou’a (A resident of Beit Iksa). (iii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Ariqat in Khan Al-Hamra area. (iv) Israeli forces detained Naseem Al-Taweel in Al-Ram. (v) Israeli forces detained two residents: Ahmad Obied and Alaa Obied in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for allegedly stoning.

	<p>(ii) At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned at the east entrance of Al-Eisawiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for allegedly stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Home Demolition: At 12:00, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood in Jerusalem and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Ziyad Al-Halawani for allegedly being built without a licence. • Confiscation of Property: At 12:00, Israeli military served a court order to “Sab Al-Labban” family to forcefully remove them from their homes in order to hand over the house to A Settlement Organization who claim they own the house. • Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Rammin village, stormed a home and detained a resident. (iii) At 02:35, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and Tulkarem camp, stormed an Office building and confiscated a computer and detained a resident then withdrew at 05:10. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Jamal Barham in Ramin village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assira Al-Shimaliya until 10:55. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints,</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces raided Iskaka village. (ii) At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 03:30. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya, stormed and searched three homes and summoned Amjad Yusef to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Qana area and served a military order for the demolition of a livestock den owned by Abdel-Fattah Zidan (A resident of Deir Istiya).

(ii) At 02:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the South entrance of Jericho until 03:05 • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Jericho as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers to a Synagoug then withdrew at 12:15. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces raided Halhoul, positioned in front of Palestinian Police Head Qaurters thyen withdrew at 02:00.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza and Central Gaza. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Central Gaza and as a result detained four fishermen.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of West Beit Lahiya. (ii) 06:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of West Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
Central GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 02:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats as they were chasing them off the shores of Al-Shate' beach and detained 4 fishermen (residents of Al-Shat'a camp) and confiscated their fishing boat. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained four fishermen: Hassan Murad, Hassan Abu Sam'an, Haytham Baker and Mohammad Baker in Deir Al-Balah.
