JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeding the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 15:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with several University students near Al-Quds University during which they fired tear gas grenades towards the students leaving them suffocated from

	<p>tear gas inhalation during which a tear gas grenade canister exploded near agricultural land and set fire to several olive trees near the University.</p> <p>(ii) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed a home and summoned Lu'ay Bassa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces detained 2 children: Mohammad Hallak (12 years old) and Layth Darwish (14 years old). • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On June 3rd 2013, Israeli forces served a demolition order for a 300m² home owned by Hussien Al-Kiswani in Beit Haninan for allegedly being built without proper licencing. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 03:00 on June 3rd 2013, Israeli settlers assaulted Na'im Aliyan a resident of Beit Safafa as he was fixing his vehicle near "Gilo" settlement leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(iii) At 14:20, Israeli forces raided the industrial zone in Jenin, stormed a factory, temporarily detained several factory workers and released them after questioning then withdrew at 19:15. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafr Thulth and Sanniriya village (ii) At 20:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Azzun and Izbat Al-Tabib. • Raid: At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya and stormed 2 homes. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) At 15:40, Israeli settlers levelled agricultural land in Beit Furiq.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Yasuf village. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Rafat village until 21:30. (iii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Ballut until 21:00. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) At 11:15, Israeli military closed the road between Nahhalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Beit Fajjar. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Hassna area in Husan village. (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Asakra village, clashed with residents as they stormed and searched a home and detained a resident. (iii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Husan village and detained 3 residents including 2 children • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:35, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Khadr, fired tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Shadi Asakra in Al-Askara village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Shusha (17 years old), Muhsin Shusha (17 years old) and Oday Shushah in Husan village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.

Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.

- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabbun area in North Hebron.
- (ii) At 14:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 11:05 and again at 21:25, Israeli forces raided Hebron, surrounded Al-Rabat mosque, temporarily detained worshippers inside the mosques, searched their identification cards then at 01:40 Israeli forces stormed a home and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Asal and detained a resident.

- **Detention:**

- (i) At 03:30 on June 3rd 2013, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Othman during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Baha Sarsour in Hebron.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Ismail Nassar in Deir Al-Asal village.

- **Home Demolition:** On June 3rd 2013, Israeli forces demolished a home owned by Amr Rjoub in east Yatta for allegedly being built without proper licencing.

- **Settlement Activity:** On June 3rd 2013, Israeli military bulldozers levelled several acres (dunumes) of land in North and East Hebron for the purpose of paving a road to connect "Ghush Atsiyon", "Kermi Tsur: and "Kiryat Arbaa" settlements as a road to be used instead of the road which leads to Al-Urub camp because of stoning by its residents.

- **Demonstration:** At 11:25, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees **and** demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
