JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Amoud area in the old city of Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents participating in an event (Al-Quds{Jerusalem} is Ours) and assaulted 2 residents including a journalist: Amin Siyam and Basel Abed and also detained 2 residents. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Ain Al-Louza area in Silwan neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards resident’s homes for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:40, Israeli forces detained Ali Abu Thiyab in Silwan neighbourhood. (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces detained Salah Qash’ab in Silwan neighbourhood. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Al-Ghoul and Samer Abu Eisheh as they were participating in an event “(Al-Quds{Jerusalem} is Ours)” near Bab Al-Amoud area in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned near Bab Al-Salalha (A main entrance gate leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem) temporarily detained two children: AYA Abu Nab (17 years old) and Iz Al-Din Al-Salaymeh (10 years old) then released them later.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 3rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh village then stormed and searched a home. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Rima, summoned 3 residents including a child: Hamza Al-Bas (17 years old), Karim Shawa and Akram Aqel to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:10. (iii) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Khirbathat Bani Harith village, stormed several homes and summoned Imad Injas to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ghalib Hamad (15 years old).
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At 07:30, Israeli forces raided Bruqin. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 09:00 on June 2nd 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Rumana village junction and demolished a water well owned by Nabeel Subihat. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Khirbeit Atouf village until 14:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:25 and again at 02:40, Israeli forces raided Tamoun, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:55. (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Tubas, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 02:20. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Bani Odeh in Tamoun. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ali Daraghme in Tubas.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:45, Israeli forces raided Attil, temporally detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli intelligence officers. (ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Allar and stormed a hair Salon and a Carpentry shop.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) At 18:15, Israeli forces raided Zietta then stormed and searched 2 homes (iv) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem, stormed a building, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:45. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Aqel in Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village, stormed a home then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huawar checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 13:00. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction located along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya until 18:45. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces raided Einbuis village, occupied a home owned by Mustafa Mohammad and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 18:40. (ii) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qalil village stormed and searched several homes and detained three residents then withdrew at 06:00. (iii) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Salem village, stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 06:40. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained three residents: Wadah Ahmad, Issam Ammar and Saddam Mansour in Kafr Qalil village. (ii) Israeli forces detained Harb Issa in Salem village.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Salfit, stormed two homes and summoned two residents: Mohammad Izzat and Tariq Fatash to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik until 04:45. • <u>Attack:</u> At 01:35, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Harris village, fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result suffocated two residents: Asam Daoud and Issa Daoud from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 01:15, an Israeli settler vehicle ran over Ahmad Sultan (Harris village) near the entrance of Harris village and as a result, left him hospitalised with contusions.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road (90) near Al-Nuemeh village located at the North entrance of Jericho until 09:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:25, Israeli forces raided Jericho, temporarily detained several residents then released them after questioning by Israeli Intelligence officers at 12:20.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and

(ii) At 11:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Taqou' until 15:10. (iii)At 00:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North West entrance of Beit Jallah until 03:00 • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 3rd 2015, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village and detained two residents including a child. (ii) At 10:55, Israeli forces raided Irtas village as they escorted a group of Israeli settler who stormed Suleiman's Pool in the village then withdrew at 11:30. (iii)At 12:20 and again at dawn on June 4th 2015, Israeli forces raided Taqou', took photographs of several hoes, stormed and searched five homes. (iv)At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Khalayel Al-Louz village until 14:25. (v) At 15:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Aorouj village until 15:55. (vi)At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village, stormed two homes then withdrew at 02:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Nur Shakarneh (17 years old) and Nassar Najjajrah in Nihalin village.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding opening fire towards Rafah. • Israeli forces broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza. • Israeli Fighter Jets broke the cease-fire agreement by launching missiles towards Gaza and Khan Yunis. • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease-fire agreement by opening fire and launching projectiles towards the Green Line.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach off the shores of West Beit Lahiya and detained five residents including a child and confiscated their fishing boat. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained five fishermen: Imad Bakr (17 years old), Waleed Bakr, Fahed Bakr, Ziyad Bakr and Na'im Bakr off the shores of West Beit Lahiya. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> On the evening of June 3rd 2015, Palestinian gunmen launched three projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Air Strike:</u> At dawn on June 4th 2015, Israeli fighter jets launched 3 missiles towards Palestinian Gunmen in Abraj Al-Maqusi located in North West Gaza and towards a car lot in Al-Zaytouneh neighbourhood located in south east Gaza.

KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Attack:</u> At 06:45 on June 3rd 2015, Israeli forces opened fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards agricultural land in Khz'a and as a result injured Fareed Al-Najjar. • <u>Air Strike:</u> At dawn on June 4th 2015, Israeli fighter jets launched three missiles towards Palestinian Gunmen in West Khan Yunis.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA. • <u>Raid:</u> On the morning of June 3rd 2015, Israeli forces escorting Military Bulldozers stormed 100m into the vicinity of Akl-Shouka area located in east Rafah and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land.
