• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- (iii) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Raid:

(i) At dawn on June 4th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya, detained 4

residents including 2 children as they stormed several homes and served a demolition order to demolish home owned by Ali Eliyan. (ii) At 08:00 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, detained a resident and clashed with several University students near A-Quds University. (iii) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident. **Denying of Access:** On June 4th 2013, Israeli forces renewed the denial of access for Sami Qudier (a guard for Al-Aqsa mosque) from entering the mosque until after the month of Ramadan after he attempted to prevent settler assault on the mosque as mentioned in the report of May 29th 2013. **Settler Violence:** (i) At 08:00, Israeli settlers seized a plot of agricultural land near Al-Khan Al-Ahmar area owned by several residents of Anata village. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Al-Tur neighbourhood in Jerusalem and stoned several vehicles and as a result damaged 3 vehicles during which Israeli forces detained 2 children as they attempted to prevent the settler assault. **Detention:** (i) On June 2nd 2013, Israeli forces detained Farahat Salameh, a resident of Al-Ram. (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Fadi Mahmoud (17 years old), Yusef Mushien (16 years old), Yahaya Issa and Ali Mustafa in Al-Isawiya (iii) Israeli forces detained Ahmad Badr in Al-Eizariya. (iv) Israeli forces detained Hamza Abu Ziyad in Al-Eizariya. (v) Israeli forces detained Amir Farouj (15 years old) and Ahmad Abu Snieneh (15 years old). • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shavyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. Raid: At 03:50, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, clashed with several residents, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:15. RAMALLAH & **AL BIREH Detention:** Israeli forces detained Ahmad Najla and Mohammad Matour in Ramallah. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages. **Closure of Main Road:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to **JENIN** the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.

Also Israeli forces demolished 4 storage sheds owned by Saleh Rashaydeh, Ibrahim Al-Ziyad, Taysir Rashaydeh and Ismail Rashaydeh during which they fired tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the demolitions and as a result caused Shaykhiya Al-Ziyad (57 years old) suffocation from tear gas inhalation.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) At dawn on June 4th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Duheisha camp, detained 2 residents and summoned Mohammad Da'amsheh and Fadi Da'amsheh to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Husan village served a demolition order for a home owned by Ibrahim Hamarna for allegedly being built without proper licencing.

- (iii)At 19:15, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and served halt to construction orders for 3 homes owned by Fadi Faraj, Mohammad Al-Bidawi and Mohammad Ayash.
- (iv) At 20:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr.

• Detention:

- (i) At 01:55 on June 4th 2013, Israeli forces detained Haron Shusheh (17 years old) during their raid into Husan.
- (ii) At 22:45, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Ayash in Beit Jallah
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Mohammad Da'amseh, and Sa'di Da'amsheh in Al-Duheisha camp.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

(vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints in at the entrances of North Hebron
- (ii) At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Al-Fahs area in south Hebron.
- (iii) At 14:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Halhul.
- (iv)At 14:40 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.
- (v) At 23:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.

Raid:

- (i) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar and detained 2 residents.
- (ii) At 07:15, Israeli forces raided Hamsa village, stormed a home and detained a resident.

• Detention:

- (i) At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ibrahimi mosque in the old city of Hebron detained Ibrahim Zuhur, a resident of Beit Ummar.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Abdel Aziz Akhlil and Mohammad Akhlil in Beit Ummar.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Raed Al-Darbi' in Humsa village.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

GAZA STRIP

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November **ALL** 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 **DISTRICTS** re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement as they raided and opened fire towards North Gaza. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad **NORTHERN** through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. **GAZA** Attack: At 17:30, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers raided 200m into the vicinity of Beit Hanun and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land then withdrew at 18:30 **Closure of Crossing Points:** Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the (i) **GAZA** Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, (ii) the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
