JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Since the evening of June 2nd 2014, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound as well as closing 3 entrances leading to Al-Aqsa mosque thus preventing residents from conducting prayers inside the mosque. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 10:00, Israeli forces closed the road leading to Wadi Hilweh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with dirt mounds • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:30 and again at 23:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, clashed with its residents and detained 4 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00 on June 3rd 2014, Israeli forces detained Farooq Sa’adeh (14 years old) as he was participating in a demonstration in solidarity with Palestinian detainees as mentioned in the previous report. (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Talib Abu Darwish, Alaa Aliyan,

	<p>Hamada Aliyan and Mohammad Aliyan in Abu Dis.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of June 4th 2014, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On June 4th 2014, The Israeli Ministry of Public works and Housing issued tenders for the construction of 1500 settlement units in “Ramat Shlomo”, “Givat Zaif”, “Alviya Mansha”, “Ifrat”, “Betar Eliyat” ,”Adam” and “Ariel” settlement located in Jerusalem, Qalqiliya, Salfit, Ramallah and Bethlehem all on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.
<p>RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. (iii) At 19:25, Israeli forces closed the bypass road connecting Shuqba and Shabtin villages with cement blocks. (iv) At 16:30, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Deir Abu Mash’al village with cement blocks for alleged stoning and then reopened it at 20:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:35, Israeli settlers positioned near “Bet El” settlement junction in North Al-Bireh city stoned residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp. • <u>Demonstration:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:40, a demonstration took place in front of the United Nations headquarters in Ramallah in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. (ii) At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of “Ofar” (military base/prison) in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces clashed with residents and fired tear gas grenades toward demonstrators and as a result suffocated several demonstrators from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the area west of ‘Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement ‘Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p>JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:30 on June 6th 2014, Israeli forces raided Jenin. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Anza village, stormed 4 homes, detained a child and summoned Fadi Sadaqa to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 05:00.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ali Atiyani (17 years old) in Anza village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Tubas and Tayasir village until 21:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:00 and again at 21:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, temporarily detained the child Mohammad Shabtiya (16 years old) then released him at alter time then withdrew at 22:55. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Irtas village until 21:00. (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Kafr Laqif village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Elisa's village. (ii) At 19:50, Israeli forces raided Habalat village. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the afternoon of June 4th 2014, Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Far'ata and Immatin villages and set fire to and destroyed several Olive trees. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

(ii) At 23:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 00:20. (iii) At 00:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Fasayil village junction until 01:20.

(ii) At dawn on June 5th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Ma’assra village, and detained a resident after storming his home. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mahmoud Zawahra in Al-Ma’sara village • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On June 4th 2014, Israeli authorities approved the construction of several settlements unites in Al-Khadr for the expansion of “Aliaz” settlement in Bethlehem all on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village. (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City.

(v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ix) Since March 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im and stormed a home. (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Rayha village and detained a resident then withdrew at 03:30. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron detained the child Mohammad Abu Amar (14 years old). (ii) Israeli forces detained Ayoub Al-Najjar in Al-Rayha village. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> On June 4th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron and set fire to several Olive trees owned by Al-Qanibi family. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 16:15, a demonstration took place near Halhul bridge located in North Hebron in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces clashed with residents and fired tear gas grenades toward demonstrators and as a result suffocated several demonstrates from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
