<p><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u></b> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Police stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>RAMALLAH &amp; AL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwad.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Sinjil and Obwein, detained a resident and temporarily detained Mazen Mazah (a Civil Defence Force officer) and released him later.</li> <li>(iii) At 22:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Abboud and Beit Rima.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and detained a University student.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b></li> </ul>

<b>JENIN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Road:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched two homes then withdrew at 01:55.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>
<b>TUBAS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Injury:</u></b> At 10:15, the child Qutaybah Sawafta (9 years old) {a resident of Tubas} was hospitalised with severe burns after an UXO (installed by Israeli forces during military exercise in the area) exploded near Ibziq village on the North Jordan valley.</li> <li>• <b><u>Home Demolition:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 07:00 on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces stormed Thara' Awad area located in east Tammoun in the North Jordan valley demolished 4 residential Baracks and tenets as well as 4 live stock dens owned by Nidal Abu Awwad, Qayed Salameen, Nitham Abu Awwad and Adel Salameen.</li> <li>(ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqaba village and served a military order for the demolition of a home owned by Ma'moun Al-Dabaak.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 09:20, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Soqut area located in east Tubas and ploughed approximately 800 Dunumes (Acres) of residential land in an attempt to confiscate the land.</li> </ul>
<b>TULKAREM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 16:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jabarah village and detained a resident.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Far'oun village, searched several homes located near the wall gate then withdrew at 04:45.</li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> Israeli forces detained Moath Hussien {A resident of Kafr Abboush village} near Jabara village.</li> </ul>
<b>QALQILIYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>NABLUS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> At 02:05 on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Jamal Al-Qani during their raid into Kafr Qalili village as mentioned in the previous report.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settlement Activity:</u></b> At 11:20, Israeli forces paved a road on residential land in the area near Qaryut and Al-Labban Al-Sharqiya village to connect “Shilo” and Eli” settlement located in the area for the purpose of installing a new settlement outpost and Israeli forces also paved a road on residential land in the area between Qabalan and Yatma village leading to “Rahalim” settlement for ten purpose of installing a new settlement outpost in the area.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 02:00, Israeli settlers stormed Joseph’s tomb in Nablus befor Palestinian Police forces were able to chase them out of the area.</li> <li>(ii) At 02:25, Israeli settlers stormed Awarta village then withdrew later.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>SALFIT</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</li> <li>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</li> <li>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> At 10:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:05.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERICHO</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 19:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 20:55.</li> <li>• <b><u>Temporary Detention:</u></b> At 11:00, Israeli forces temporarily detained Ayoub Damar (A resident of Aqbat Al-Jabr) as he was travelling to Jerusalem then released him at 03:15.</li> </ul>

**BETHLEHEM**

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
  - (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
  - (iii) Since August 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
  - (iv) Since May 8<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
  - (v) Since June 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
  - (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29<sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
  - (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
  - (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
  - (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 16:30.
  - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement junction and detained a resident for allegedly finding a knife in his possession.
  - (iii) At 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 21:05.
  - (iv) At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Beit Ta'mar village until 22:20.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At dawn on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village and detained three residents.
  - (ii) At dawn on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Aayda camp in Bethlehem and summoned 2 residents: Murad Darwish and Farouq Bader to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- **Detention:**
  - (i) Israeli forces positioned a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement junction detained Salah Dariya (A resident of Beit Fajjar).

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</li> <li>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.</li> <li>(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) Since July 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) At 17:00, Israeli forces closed the gate leading to a plot of land owned by Mohammad Al-Ja'bari in Qizoun area in the old city of Hebron</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', stormed a home, assaulted a 65-year-old woman: Halimeh Khalajiya and her 70-year-old husband: Ahmad Al-Daghamin leaving them hospitalised with contusions.</li> <li>(ii) At dawn on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahiriya, detained 2 residents after storming their homes.</li> <li>(iii) At dawn on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Dura and detained a resident after storming his home</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained Nasser Abu Hadid during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained two residents: Musa Samara and Ibrahim Samara in Al-Thahriya.</li> <li>(iii) Israeli forces detained Fawzi Abu Dush in Dura.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Land Levelling:</u></b> On June 4<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces levelled a plot of land located in Qaznat Hadid and Sha'b Al-Sayf area's located in west Surif and as a result uprooted several Olive trees as they demolished 3 water wells owned by Ighnimat family.</li> </ul>
