JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque. (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem. (ii) As of 11 April 2010, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp in the city of Jerusalem and prevent daily civilian traffic access from 23:00 until 05:00. The closure of the checkpoint will continue for a week and half under the pretext of maintenance and setting up an infrastructure between the checkpoint and the road leading to Shu'fat refugee camp. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Ar-Ram town. (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Abu Dis town. (iii) At 15:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Hizma village. • Attack: At 22:00, the Israeli army in the neighborhood of Silwan in Jerusalem city fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas bombs towards a number of civilians under the pretext of throwing stones. The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the neighborhood of Silwan in Jerusalem city the civilians: Emad Khalil Al Abbasi; Salah Sameeh Sarhan; Muhammad Abed Odeh and his brother Khalil. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians

	<p>holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu’fat refugee camp.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village, Safa village and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya. (ii) On 15 March 2010, the Israeli army issued military order declaring the area located between civilian houses and the Wall in the town of Ni’lin and the village of Bil’in as closed military zones from 08:00 until 20:00 every Friday and for a period of 6 months. Civilian access is denied during the mentioned period without a special permit in order to prevent the weekly demonstrations against the Wall. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the towns and villages of ‘Abud and Bil’in, and in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to ‘Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Bir Al Basha village. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli army helicopter airborne infantry troops raided and patrolled the forest area that is located near the eastern neighborhood of Jenin city. (iii) At 01:45, the Israeli army raided Jenin city and its refugee camp where confrontations took place with civilians while patrolling the refugee camp. The Israeli army withdrew at 03:45. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
TOUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint, east of the city of Tubas, allowing civilian access from 06:00 to 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 21:00, Israeli army helicopter airborne infantry troops raided and combed the area between the town of Kafr Ra’i and Seida village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 22:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Zeita town. • Detentions: At 09:25, Israeli troops positioned at Einav checkpoint detained 2 Palestinian National Security officers, a Police officer and a number of civilians. The Israeli army released them at a later time following DCO intervention. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of ‘Azzun. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to the village of Jinsafut. (ii) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint under the overpass leading to the town of Azzun (on Qalqiliya – Tulkarm main road) and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of Hajja and Al Funduq and searched civilians and vehicles. (iv) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the middle of An-Nabi Elias village and searched civilians and vehicles. (v) At 14:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Azzun. Again at 18:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles. (vi) At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Izbat At-Tabib and searched civilians and vehicles until 00:50. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. (ii) On 12 May 2010, the Israeli army erected an iron gate at the entrance to the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha (after removing the iron gate erected at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya), and prevented civilians from the village from passing through it. The Israeli army only allows the passage of students to their schools outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through the iron gate # 109.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the roads of Tel-Burin, Beit Furik-Salem, and the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya; and with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Duma, the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya, the western entrances to the town of Aqraba and the village of Majdal Bani Fadil, the northern entrance to the town of

	<p>Qabalan, as well as the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to Alon Moreh settlement.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) The Israeli army continues to close by an iron gate the western entrance to An Naqura village, opposite Shavi Shomron settlement. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut and the road connecting the town of Aqraba to the village of Osarin. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the side road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00. (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Zeita Jamma'in and searched a house. (ii) At 20:15, the Israeli army raided the town of Huwwara and occupied the roof of a house overlooking the junction leading to the town of Beita and converted it into a military post. (iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Jamma'in, searched a number of houses and withdrew at 22:00. (iv) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Beita, searched 3 houses and withdrew at 04:00. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:00, a group of Israeli settlers from the settlement of Bracha hurled stones towards 15-year-old child Dheeb Aref Qadous from the village of Iraq Burin. As a result, he sustained fractures in the hand and the leg from falling while attempting to escape the settler attack. Consequently, he was evacuated to hospital for treatment.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin and the western entrance to the town of Kafr Ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan, searched a house and withdrew at 11:25. (ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Sarta. (iii) At 21:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Kifl Hares town. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.

<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-‘Auja with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-‘Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those possessing permits. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Mu’arrajat Road, which connects the districts of Jericho and Ramallah, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction leading to Road # 90 in the middle of Al Auja village. • Settler Violence: At 11:30, an Israeli settler driving his vehicle on Road # 90 near the village of Marj Al Ghazal ran over the civilian Jihad Muhammad Abu Jarrar. As a result, Abu Jarrar sustained serious injuries and evacuated to an Israeli hospital.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu’mān, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access to an area that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town of Taqu’a and the village of Khirbet Al Baq’a. • Flying Checkpoint: At 21:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to Janata town and searched civilians and vehicles. • Detentions: At 12:40, the Israeli army at As Sawahira Ash Sharqiya (the ‘Container’) checkpoint detained a Palestinian National Security officer and a Civil Police officer and released them at a later time following DCO intervention. • Demonstration: At 11:20, a mass demonstration, with the participation of international peace activists, set about in the area of Al Kreimzan, northwest of Beit Jala city, in protest at the leveling of civilian land for completing the construction of the Wall. Confrontations took place with the Israeli army causing suffocation to 4 demonstrators as a result of tear gas inhalation. The Israeli army detained an international activist. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the area located near the Green Line, south of Yatta town, evacuating the area of those inside it and denying them access to it.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the villages of Al Karmil and At Tuwani and all roads leading to bypass Road # 60.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
 - (i) At 09:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass leading to Halhul town. Again at 19:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 11:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Wadi Ash Sharq Road in Sa'ir town and searched civilians and vehicles.
- **Raids:**
 - (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Sa'ir, set up a flying checkpoint at its entrance and patrolled the area.
 - (ii) At 14:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron and served summons to 5 civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.
 - (iii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided Al Arrub refugee camp, searched a number of houses and arrested 3 civilians, including a child.
 - (iv) At 04:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Ash-Shuyukh town.
 - (v) At 04:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ummar where confrontations took place with civilians while searching a number of houses. The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrests: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:50, the Israeli army arrested near Al Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron the university student Ahmad Muhammad Hussein As-Suwaiti under the pretext of finding a knife in his possession. (ii) The Israeli army arrested in Al Arrub refugee camp the civilians: Ahmad Haytham Ahmad Al Badawi, 17-year-old; Noor Ahmad Atallah Al Badawi; and Ali Jamal Ali Al Badawi. (iii) The Israeli army arrested in the town of Beit Ummar the civilians: Waseem Jamal Al Wahadeen; Saif Rabih Bahr; and Tamer Isma'il Awad. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period. • The Israeli army violated the ceasefire by opening fire intensively from its locations on the Green Line in the districts of Northern Gaza and Gaza. An Israeli UAV aircraft also fired a missile on Northern Gaza district. In addition, Israeli navy boats opened machine gunfire intensively and fired a number of missile mortars towards a boat carrying armed Palestinian individuals at sea in Central Gaza district. As a result, 4 armed Palestinian individuals were killed, 1 was missing and 3 civilians, including 2 armed Palestinian individuals, were injured.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for previously coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals. • Attack: In the morning of 07 June 2010, the Israeli army opened fire intensively from its locations in the periphery of Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing towards a number of civilians north of Beit Hanun town. As a result, the civilian Adham Al Kafarneh was injured. • Air Attack: In the morning of 07 June 2010, An Israeli UAV aircraft fired a missile against armed Palestinian individuals in the area of Sha'sha'ah square, that is located east of Jabalya town, injuring 1 of them.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. (ii) Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision. • Attack: In the morning of 07 June 2010, the Israeli army opened fire intensively from its locations on the Green Line towards agricultural land northeast of Gaza city.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 04:30, Israeli navy boats opened machine gunfire intensively and fired a number of missile mortars towards a boat carrying armed Palestinian individuals at sea opposite the beach of An-Nusseirat refugee camp. As a result, 4 armed Palestinian individuals were killed, 1 was missing and 1 was injured. In addition, the boat was destroyed. • Killings: The Israeli army killed at sea opposite the beach of An Nusseirat refugee camp: Fayez Al Fairi; Muhammad Qwaider; Ibrahim Al Wahidi; and Hamed Hasan Thabet.
KHAN YOUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Activities not reported.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al Awdah) Crossing is open on exceptional basis for the departure of patients, students and holders of visas, and for the entry of civilians and patients who received medical treatment at Egyptian hospitals. In addition to the entry of 36 Arab parliamentarians and 3 ambulances donated by the Union of Arab Physicians. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is partially open for the transport of food, humanitarian assistance, a quantity of industrial diesel for the electricity plant and cooking gas.

POLITICAL PRISONERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prison Sentence: The Israeli military court at Salem Military Camp sentenced political prisoner Tayoon Abdulhadi Tayoon from the district of Qalqiliya to life imprisonment.
