#### **WEST BANK**

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

#### • Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Raid: At dawn on June 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, stormed a home and detained a resident.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured Tarik Dweik.

#### • <u>Detention:</u>

- (i) At 06:00, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Terwai in the old city of Jerusalem.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Abed Al-Amouri in Al-Eizariya.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 16:00 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya until 21:30.
- (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the North and South entrances of Azzun and at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village.
- <u>Detention:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned at the wall gate leading to Azzun Atma village detained Hassan Nazal, a resident of Azzun.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement for Sabbath Holiday.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:10.

#### • Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Farouq until 20:20.
- (ii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 22:00.

#### **NABLUS**

#### • <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Assira. Al-Shamaliya until 01:20.
- (ii) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Yassid village, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, detained a University student then withdrew at 02:20.
- (iii) At 04:55, Israeli forces raided Nablus and detained 2 residents.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Issam Thaher (A University Student) in Yassid village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Amjad Anabtawi and Ali Shamat in Nablus.
- <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 19:00, a group of Israeli settlers assaulted and injured a child: Yusef Qaddus (13 years old) leaving him hospitalised with a broken arm after he

	fell as they were assaulting him near "Burja" settlement.

	(vi) Since 13:20 on September 29 <sup>th</sup> 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
	(vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.

- (viii) On January 28<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur, temporarily detained Kamal Shawarat (A Palestinian intelligence officer) and released him at a later time then withdrew at 14:55.

#### • Raid:

- (i) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Mina village located in south Taqou', stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 01:50.
- (ii) At 02::45, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, stormed a home and detained a resident.
- (iii)At 03:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Duheisha camp in Bethlehem, stormed a home, summoned Mohammad Ayad to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.

#### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Moath Al-Badan in Tagou'.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Nu'man Abiyat in Bethlehem.

#### • Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala town for Sabbath Holiday.
- (ii)On May 1<sup>st</sup> 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21<sup>st</sup> 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

#### • Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23<sup>rd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to

#### **HEBRON**

"Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.

- (viii) Since March 9<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Haji" settlement junction in south Hebron and temporarily seized the Governor of Hebron's convoy then allowed it to pass through at a later time.
- Raid:
  - (i) At 04:00 on June 7<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp and summoned 5 residents including a child: Zakjariya Al-Qiq (17 years old), Mohammad Al-Mazin, Imad Al-Jindi, Sa'id Banat and Khaled Jawabra to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
  - (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Baraka area in Hebron.
  - (iii)At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Buriej village and stormed 2 homes.
  - (iv) At 17:00, Israeli forces raided Hanina area in Dura.
  - (v) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 05:00.
  - (vi)At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Rayha area and summoned Ismail Al-Najjar to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning.
  - (vii)At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Fuwar camp, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes and detained 2 children.
- <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 2 children: Mohammad Abu Ta'miya (15 years old) and Salameh Da'ajneh (17 years old) in Al-Fuwar camp.
- <u>Settler Violence</u>: At 12:30, Israeli forces stormed Al-Tawani village in Yatta and assaulted several farmers as they were harvesting wheat crops.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

#### ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards residents in Rafah.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

### NORTHERN GAZA

- Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed
- Attack: On the morning of June 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of West Beit Lahiya.
- <u>Killing:</u> At 06:30 on June 8<sup>th</sup> 2014, Imad Salam died of injuries sustained after Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards his fishing boat off the shores of Beit Lahiya as mentioned in May 27<sup>th</sup> 2014 Report.
