Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem (i) city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Agsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. **Checkpoints: JERUSALEM** (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. Attack: On June 8th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Shu'fat checkpoint junction fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. Assault on Places of Worship: At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Agsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. **RAMALLAH &** Flying Checkpoint: At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the main entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp until 01:30. **AL BIREH** Raid: (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Bireh city, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 12:30.

- (ii) At 12:35, Israeli forces positioned at "Mitar" crossing point located along the Green Line in south Al-Thahriya detained Samiya Ghanimat (A resident of Surif) as she was travelling to visits her son in Israeli prison.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained three residents: Mohammad Al-Namourah, Adham Al-Namourah and Sultan Al-Namourah in Dura.

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the Shores of North Gaza and Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA

- <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 10:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya area located in west Beit Lahiya.
- Raid: At 13:00 on June 5th 2015, Israeli forces escorting several Military bulldozers stormed 150m into the vicinity of Al-Shuhada cemetery located in east Jabaliya and levelled a plot of land.
