### **HEBRON**

Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

### Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Wadi Qabbun area located in North Hebron.

### Raid

- (i) At dawn on June 9<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed a home and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a home, set up a checkpoint, temporarily detained and questioned several residents then released them after summoning them to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 16:35.
- (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Samit village.
- (iv) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Dura, stormed and searched several homes, detained 4 residents then withdrew at 03:30.
- (v) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp, stormed and searched 2 homes and detained 2 residents.

### • Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained Muhanad Raba'I in Yatta.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Abdallah Abu Sharrar, Mu'taz Abu Atwan, Islam Shanan and Ghadfanar Abu Atwan in Dura.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Maher Abu Warda and Nidal Balasi in Al-Urub camp.
- <u>Assault on Property:</u> On June 9<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces served a halt to construction notice on the construction of a water well owned by Atta Jabr in Al-Buq'a area located in East Hebron.
- <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

# At 21:00 on November 21<sup>st</sup> 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14<sup>th</sup> 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21<sup>st</sup> 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
