JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Silwan neighbourhood. (ii) At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba’ village junction. • <u>Detention:</u> At 11:30, Israeli forces detained two children: Ahmad Yassin (17 years old) and Kareem Siyam (15 years old). • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 06:00 on June 9th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Khalayleh neighbourhood in Al-Jib village, demolished a steel, mill and two vehicle repair shops owned by Nur Al-Matari, Muhanad Mansour and Hamoud Abu Ja’far for allegedly being built without licences. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 05:30, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers stormed the south area of Al-Eisawiya and levelled a plot of agricultural land and as a result uprooted 150 Olive trees, demolished a Green house, a water well and surrounding concrete fence owned by Sabri Darwish. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Saleh village junction until 15:20. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 04:00 on June 9th 2015, raided Jifnah village and detained three residents. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and Al-Bireh cities, stormed a building in Al-Bireh city then withdrew at 04:20. • Detention: Israeli forces detained three residents: Yacoub Hussein, Suliman Hussien and Tariq Ali in Jifnah village.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • Raid: At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, clashed with several residents and as a result killed a resident and detained a resident then withdrew at 03:40. • Killing: Israeli forces killed Iz-Al-Din Bani Gharra in Jenin camp. • Arrest: the detained in Jenin was Ahmmad Kifah Al Nusrra. • Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoint: Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Lid, clashed with several residents, and temporarily detained a child: Mohammad Daridi (15 years old) then released him at 21:45. (ii) At 04:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 07:30.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • Raid: At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Azzun, temporarily detained a resident: Ribhi Al-Khouli then released him later and summoned Wahbi Al-Khouli to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. • Physical Assault: At 01:45, Israeli forces positioned near Azzun Atma village assaulted Tawfiq Ammar (A resident of Bidya) as he attempted to enter Israel for work and as a result, left him hospitalised with broken legs and contusions. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close

	<p>with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</p>
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00 and again at 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction located along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya until 19:30. (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burqa village until 13:50. (iii) At 15:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yatma village until 16:00. (iv) At 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Nablus and Assirah Al-Shimaliya. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Awarta and stormed two homes. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Ahmad Da’as in Askar camp.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Hassan, stormed a carpentry mill, and temporarily detained two residents: Hamza Assi and Muhtasib Assi then released them after questioning and withdrew at 14:40. (ii) At 02:50, Israeli forces Sarta village and detained 2 residents • Arrest: the two detained in the village of Sarta were Ata Yassin, and his son Sameh.

(ii) At 22:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the South entrance of Jericho until 23:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village until 09:20. (ii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Jericho and Aqbat Al-Jabr camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed three homes in the camp and as result suffocated four residents from tear gas inhalation and temporarily detained two residents: Nael Abu Assal and Wael Abu Assaal then released them later then withdrew at 03:40. • <u>Detention:</u> At 00:40, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Hamid Mo'yad Hamid (A resident of Beit Annan village in Jerusalem) as he was returning from Jordan. Then released him later. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 00:04 Israeli Forces temporary Detained Muhammed Humaid from the village of Beit Annan at Allenby Bridge.
<p style="text-align: center;">BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. <p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

(ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
