DISTRICT	EVENT
ALL DISTRICTS	Since 22 March 2004, the Israeli army has imposed a total closure over the West Bank and Gaza Strip. The Israeli army prevented civilians from crossing the Green Line and entering Jerusalem, closed crossing points to workers, and restricted movement between cities in the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the city, closing all roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis, Al Sawahira al Sharqiya, Sur Bahir, Qatanna, Biddu, along the main road between Dahiyat Al Bareed checkpoint and Qalandiya checkpoint, and near Qalandiya airport. • Raid: The Israeli army raided the town of Al Ram and Dahiyat Al Barid, raided 2 mosques, detained and questioned dozens of worshipers in an open field near Mu'ath bin Jabal mosque and served summons to civilians to report to the Israeli General Security Services. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Bakir Muhammad Shiha at a checkpoint set up near the entrance to the village of Anata.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the Wall continues in Budrus, Deir Qaddis, Rantis, Ni'lin, Beit Liqya, Beituniya and near the village of Midya. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:30 on 10 June 2004, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr 'Ein, searched several houses and arrested 2 civilians. (ii) On 10 June 2004, the Israeli army raided the village of Beitin, searched several houses and arrested 2 civilians. (iii) On 10 June 2004, the Israeli army raided the village of Burqa, searched several houses and arrested 2 civilians. (iv) At 18:40, the Israeli army raided the cities of Ramallah and El Bireh, raided a wedding party, detained its guests, and arrested 3 civilians, including the groom and 1 Palestinian General Intelligence officer. JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health

	<p>facilities.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues south of Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, Raba, Al Mughayyir, Bardala and 'Ein al Beida and towards the Jordan River. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Jalqamus and searched several houses before withdrawing at 23:30. (ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, opened intensive fire, injuring 1 civilian, searched several houses and arrested 3 civilians before withdrawing at 05:40. (iii) The Israeli army raided the village of Deir Abu Da'if, searched several houses and arrested 2 civilians. (iv) The Israeli army raided the town of Al Yamun and arrested 1 civilian. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Jenin: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Mustafa Nadir Atiq; (ii) Muhammad Nadir Atiq; and (iii) Ahmad Sa'di. <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Deir Abu Da'if:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) Bakir Muhammad Elayyat; and (v) Adil Khalid. <p>The Israeli army 1 civilian in the town of Al Yamun.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (vi) Muhammad Khalil Al Dierawi. <p>At 13:30, the Israeli army arrested 1 civilian at the Salim Military court while he was attending his brother's hearing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (vii) Showqi Sabir Abahra.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing civilians from crossing. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it under jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality. • Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall continues north of the district of Bethlehem, west of Wadi Hilwa, near the Armenian monastery, on the Jerusalem-Bethlehem road and along the tunnel road (Gilo) and road #60- Husan. • Land Confiscation: The Israeli authorities issued confiscation orders for dozens of <i>dunums</i> of land for the construction of an Israeli settler bypass

	<p>road connecting the settlement of Har Homa located on Jabal Abu Ghuneim to a military base that will be build on land from the villages of Al Khas and Al Nu'man.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and searched several shops. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army killed 1 civilian. (ii) At 21:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Jala and took position in several neighbourhoods. • Killing: The Israeli army killed Shahir Owni Ahmad Taqatqa in the town of Beit Fajjar.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and its suburbs and patrolled the area. At 00:40, the Israeli army took position in several neighbourhoods and withdrew at 03:00. (ii) At 23:30, the Israeli army raided Tulkarem refugee camp and took position at its northern entrance. At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the area again, opened intensive fire and withdrew at 03:00. (iii) At 00:35, the Israeli army raided the town of Irtah, set up a checkpoint in the centre of the town and searched civilians.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Raid: At 20:45, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the city of Nablus and took position in several neighbourhoods. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army killed 1 child. An Israeli army jeep deliberately ran over 2 civilians, including 1 child. The Israeli army severely beat 1 child before withdrawing at 04:00. • Killing: The Israeli army killed Hani Mahmoud Qandil, 13 years old, in the city of Nablus. • Settler Violence: At 10:50, an Israeli settler driving on the main road in the town of Huwwara ran over Intisar Sa'id Odeh, a 59 year old female, who was transferred to hospital for injuries sustained during the attack.

<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on 9 June 2004, the Israeli army raided Al Arrub refugee camp, searched several houses, and arrested 8 civilians. (ii) The Israeli army raided the town of Yatta and searched several houses and shops. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 8 civilians in Al Arrub refugee camp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Hasan Ahmad Al Badawi; (ii) Hussein Al Badawi; (iii) Ahmad Khamis Al Badawi; (iv) Mustafa Mahdi Al Badawi; (v) Nidal Abu Areish; (vi) Fadi Jawabra; (vii) Anwar Jayir Jawabra; and (viii) Mahmoud Rabah Jawabra.
<p style="text-align: center;">QALQILYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. (ii) The Israeli army prohibited medics from the Palestinian Ministry of Health from crossing the Azzun Atma Wall gate in order to carry out immunisation of children. The Israeli army prevented staff of the Palestinian Central Bureau of Statistics from accessing the village in order to conduct a survey of the area and forced trucks transporting food supplies to empty their cargo near the gate for inspection. • Arrest: At 17:00, the Israeli army arrested Khaled Ahmad Abdul Rahim Salim, a college student, at a checkpoint set up near the entrance to the village of Jinsafut.
<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing dozens of entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. • Wall Construction: The Israeli authorities continue to level cultivated land west of the village of Al Zawiya for construction of the Wall. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:15, the Israeli army raided the village of Kifl Haris, took

	<p>position in the area surrounding the tomb of An Nabi Yashu' in order to protect Israeli settlers visiting the site.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Deir Ballut, surveyed the area and placed markers in preparation for construction of the Wall.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstration: At 13:00, a demonstration took place in the village of Al Zawiya against construction of the Wall. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army fired rubber coated steel bullets, injuring 130 civilians by tear gas inhalation.

GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Beit Hanun crossing is closed. • Attacks: <p>(i) At 18:00 on 9 June 2004, Israeli naval boats opened fire towards a fishing boat in the sea opposite the area of Al Sudaniya, severely damaging the boat, and arrested 2 fishermen.</p> <p>(ii) At 22:10, the Israeli army opened intensive fire towards a Palestinian National Security location east of the town of Beit Lahiya.</p> • Raid/Land Levelling: At 13:00, the Israeli army, including 4 tanks and 5 bulldozers, raided 400 meters into the area east of the town of Beit Hanun, demolished 6 houses and levelled agricultural land. At 16:40, the Israeli army occupied several houses and converted them into military posts. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 fishermen near Al Sudaniya: <p>(i) Mahmoud Muhammad Bakir; and</p> <p>(ii) Muhammad Muhammad Bakir.</p> • House Demolitions: The Israeli army demolished 6 houses east of the town of Beit Hanun belonging to the families of Al Ja'rur, Al Barbar, Abu Jabba, Al Attar, Al Selani, Al Jabali.
GAZA CITY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The junction of Nitsareem remains closed. • Raids: <p>(i) At 10:00, Israeli Special Forces raided 800 meters into the area of Juh ad Dik, south of the city of Gaza, and searched 1 house.</p> <p>(ii) At 16:45, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided 200 meters east of Gaza city. At 04:00, Israeli Special Forces raided the area again, detained and interrogated 1 civilian for 4 hours and searched 1 house.</p> <p>(iii) At 01:20, the Israeli army raided the area east of Al Shuhada' junction, south the city of Gaza, and searched 1 house.</p>
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 23:20, the Israeli army opened intensive fire from its location surrounding the settlement of Kfar Daroom towards civilian houses south of the city of Deir Al Balah, injuring 1 civilian.

KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (iii) Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road (Al Tuffah checkpoint) is closed. (iv) Abu Holi road is partially open. At 12:20, and again at 18:40 and 20:35, the Israeli army closed Salah ad Din road near Abu Holi checkpoint and arrested 13 civilians, including 7 Palestinian Police officers and 1 Palestinian National Security officer. • Raid: At 15:10, the Israeli army, including 2 tanks, 2 bulldozers and 1 military engineering unit, raided 400 meters into the area of Al Qarara, north of the Kissufim road, and withdrew at 16:50. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 13 civilians at the Abu Holi checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Muhammad Rafiq Al Majayda, a Palestinian Police officer; (ii) Muhammad Abu Jazar, a Palestinian Police officer; (iii) Nabhan Isleih, a Palestinian Police officer; (iv) Sabir Isleih, a Palestinian Police officer; (v) Baha Al Dali, a Palestinian Police officer; (vi) Ishaq Al Badrasawi, a Palestinian Police officer; (vii) Wiam Abu Daqa, a Palestinian Police officer; (viii) Muhammad Zaqut, a Palestinian National Security officer; (ix) Imad Zaqut (x) Rafat Al Mirawi; and (xi) 3 unidentified civilians. • Detention: At 10:00, the Israeli army detained 20 civilians for several hours at Al Tuffah checkpoint.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Gaza International Airport remains closed. (ii) The Rafah crossing is closed to civilians between the ages of 16 and 35. (iii) The Sufa crossing is partially open to construction cargo only.

POLITICAL PRISONERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hunger Strike: Political prisoners in Etzion Military Detention Centre began a 1 day hunger strike in protest against the administration's harsh treatment of detainees, including the lack of provision of medication to political detainees.
