WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Oalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free the flow of traffic.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata until 13:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Ram until 11:20.
- (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis, stormed and searched several homes and detained 3 residents.
- (iii) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Beit Anan village until 13:00.
- (iv) On the afternoon of June 10th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya village and clashed with its residents.

JERUSALEM

(v) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Bir Nabala, detained a resident then withdrew at 23:15.

• Detention:

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces positioned at Jab'a checkpoint detained Omar Manasra, a resident of Qalandiya camp.
- (ii) At:18:00, Israeli forces positioned at Salah Al-Din road in Jerusalem detained Alaa Al-Hadad (A Preventive Security Force Officer)
- (iii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned at one of the main entrance gates leading to Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem detained Abdel Rahman Al-Sharif (A Mosque Guard).
- (iv) On June 10th 2014, Israeli forces detained Hassan Al-Ferawi (A resident of Jerusalem) as he was reporting to Israeli police based on a prior summon.
- (v) Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Musa, Hisham Al-Rajabi and Omar Sa'id in Abu Dis.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Shabi Abdallah (A resident of Beit Ur Al-Tahta village in Ramallah) whole he was in Bir Nabala.
- Attack: At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- Obstruction of Places of Worship: At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers during which Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades towards several residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault and as a result left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- <u>Land Levelling:</u> On June 10th 2014, Israeli forces stormed Wadi Al-Juz area in Jerusalem and levelled a plot of land.
- **<u>Demonstration:</u>** At 18:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainee and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) Since 19:25 on June 3rd 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Shuqba and Shaba tin village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Kar Kar until 12:05.
- (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Atara Bridge in North Bir Zeit.

- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur, temporarily seized a Palestinian Police vehicle then allowed it to pass through after searching and inspecting it at 09:30.

• Raid:

- (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Rashayida village, summoned 3 residents: Ayoun Rashaydeh, Naser Rashaydeh and Othman Rashaydeh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
- (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Ubeidiya until 17:30.
- (iii)At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Taqou 'and detained 3 residents including a child then withdrew at 02:55.
- **<u>Detention:</u>** Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Ahmad Al-Amour (14 years old), Musa Al-Amour (15 years old) and Karim Al-Amour in Taqou'.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 10:00, a demonstration took place in front of the Church of Nativity in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour

HEBRON

- roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil until 09:00.

• Raid:

- (i) At 13:30 and again at 15:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed a coffee shop then withdrew at 16:00.
- (ii) At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Awwa until 23:00.

Attack:

- (i) At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Awwa fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Arrub camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents inside the camp and as a result injured Amir Al-Teti and detained 2 residents including a child.

• Detention:

- (i) At 21:10 on June 9th 2014, Israeli forces detained Malek Abu Al-Dab'at during their raid into Hebron.
- (ii) At 09:00, Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Abu Hussein in Abu Sneineh neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron.
- (iii)Israeli forces detained Mohammad Jawabra (17 years old) and Ibrahim Basali in Al-Urub camp.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire.
- On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles.
- Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line (As alleged by the Israeli Military).

• Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is partially open for the passage of

GAZA	critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	Palestinian Attack: On the morning of June 11 th 2014, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line (As alleged by the Israeli Military).
