	Demonstration: At 12:00, a demonstration took place in front of the international Red Cross headquarters in Jerusalem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees on hunger strike and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
	• Wall Gates:  (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in
	Abu Dis town.  (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
