| <b>JERUSALEM</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque.</li> <li>(ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(ii) As of 11 April 2010, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp in the city of Jerusalem and prevent daily civilian traffic access from 23:00 until 05:00. As a result, he sustained contusions and evacuated to hospital for treatment.</li> <li>• <b><u>Destruction of Property:</u></b> At 19:40, the Israeli army at the military observation tower on Al Fawwar junction hurled stones towards civilian vehicles. As a result, the windshield of a vehicle belonging to the civilian Atef Kamel Nassar was destroyed.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 12:30, a group of Israeli settlers near the village of At-Tawani severely beat 3 civilians, including 2 civilian women, causing them contusions.</li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 14:30, a mass demonstration, with the participation of international peace activists, set about in the old city of Hebron in protest at settlement activities and to demand the opening of Ash Shuhada' Street and freedom of movement for civilians.</li> <li>(ii) At 16:50, a mass demonstration, with the participation of international peace activists, set about in the town of Beit Ummar against settler attacks and to enable civilians to cultivate their land located near the settlement of Karmi Tsur.
