(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (ii) On June 12th 2012, Israeli forces detained Na’el Abu Sariya after confiscating his computer in Al-Thoury neighbourhood in Jerusalem. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On June 12th 2012, Israeli authority court ordered the demolition of a home owned by Fakhri Abu Diyab located in Silwan and fined him 35000 NIS approximately \$9000. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces demolished several barracks and destroyed 20 tons of wheat owned by Aziz Ja’abis and forced him to pay for the demolition process. (ii) On June 12th 2012, Israeli forces demolished 6 merchant shops under construction for allegedly not having proper licencing. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma ’ale Adumim.

(ii) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad and Kafr Ra’i.

(ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and stormed a vehicle repair shop. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Mir'i • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Al-Fuduq and Jinsafut villages. (ii) At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jit village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positioned behind the Green Line towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Attack: At 06:00 on June 12th 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Beit Lahiya.
