JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Abu Dis junction, opened fire, fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces detained Najah Bakirat (Head of Al-Aqsa Mosque) a resident of Sur Bahar. • <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> At 11:30, Israeli settlers under the protection

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Flying Checkpoint: At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba' junction. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Jenin. (ii) At dawn on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qud, stormed and searched a home after destroying the front entrance of Salah Ghazawi's home using explosives. • Demonstration: At 11:00, a demonstration in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in Jenin in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: At 15:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 16:20.

QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Jit village. (ii) At 22:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun, prevented residents from entering or exiting the town for alleged stoning of settler vehicles near the main road and stormed and searched a home in the eastern part of town. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with its residents as they stormed a home and summoned Nur Yassin to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:50. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:00, Israeli forces fired tear gas grenades and flash grenades towards residents as they stormed Jayyus. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:35, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic and at 21:00 closed the checkpoint for the alleged shooting at a Israeli settlers vehicle in south Nablus then reopened it at a later time. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>

(ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Awarta and Udlala villages until 01:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed archaeological sites in the village until 13:20. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Awarta village, stormed 2 homes and detained 3 residents. (iii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with its residents then withdrew at 23:15. (iv) At 23:05, Israeli forces raided Beita. (v) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Sara village, served demolition orders for 5 homes owned by: Alaa Abu Turabi, Hilmi Abu Turabi, Mahmoud Abu Turabi, Zahi Abu Turabi and Mohammad Abu Turabi for allegedly being built without proper licencing. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Mohammad Awad, Lu'ay Qawariq and Mohammad Qawariq. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> Israeli authorities approved the construction of 675 settlement unites in "Itmar" settlement located between Beit Furiq and Awarta village on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:30, Israeli settlers stormed Khirbeit Yanun village and levelled a plot of land then withdrew at 15:20. (ii) At 21:30, Israeli settlers stormed the area between Huwara and Jit village and opened fire towards vehicles and residents passing along the main road connecting Nablus and Qalqiliya. (iii) At 22:40, Israeli settlers stormed the outskirts of Burin village, attacked a home owned by Bashir Hamza with fire bombs then withdrew under the protection of Israeli forces.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 18:30 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bruqin village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces closed Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Detention:</u> At 06:50, on June 12th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Humra

	<p>checkpoint detained 5 residents of whom was identified: Saleh Daraghmeh and released them at a later time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 11:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Jericho in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. • <u>Raid:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar. (ii) At 07:50, Israeli forces raided Marah Rabah, stormed a home and detained a resident. (iii) At dawn on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces raided Harmala village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Anas Al-Shiek in Marah Rabah. (ii) Israeli forces detained Hamza Al-Zir in Harmala village. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction,

the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samou' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

- **Flying Checkpoint:** At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.

- **Raid:**

- (i) At 14:10 on June 11th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Tabaqa village and detained a resident.
- (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya as they apprehended a vehicle and detained a resident and again at 04:00 and stormed and searched a Pharmacy and a merchant shop.
- (iii) At 10:50 and again at 00:50, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 04:05.
- (iv) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', served demolition orders for 3 water wells owned by Ahmad Aqil, Fatima Abu Aqil and Qayed Al-Salamin and also served a demolition order to demolish a home owned by Hazem Abu Aqel for allegedly being built without proper licencing.
- (v) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Khursa village.
- (vi) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Zif village, stormed several homes and detained 3 residents.
- (vii) At dawn on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces raided Dura, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and confiscated several documents and a computer.
- (viii) At dawn on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, detained a residents as they stormed a home.
- (ix) At dawn on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces raided Yatta and detained a resident as they stormed his home.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli forces detained Anas Abu Atwan in Al-Tabaqa village.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained Rami Awasiya in Al-Thahriya.
- (iii) Israeli forces detained Jibril Amar, Alaa Ghayth and Muhammad Mur in Zif village.
- (iv) Israeli forces detained Hussein Amro (60 years old) in Dura.
- (v) Israeli forces detained Raed Adi in Beit Ummar.
- (vi) Israeli forces detained Jibril Amour in Yatta.

- **Physical Assault:** At 20:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Urub camp assaulted Abdallah Zidan (**A University Student**) as he was exiting

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by raiding and opening fire towards Khan Yunis.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination and allowed 20 truckloads of humanitarian goods.

Detainees Update

- Israeli military court sentenced 5 detainees: Khaldoun Al-Barghouthi to 46 months in prison imposed a fine of 6000 NIS approximately \$1700, Mohammad Dahla to 42 months imposed a fine of 6000 NIS approximately \$1700, Murad Abu Al-Baha to 46 months in prison imposed a fine of 6000 NIS approximately \$1700, Adnan Abu Shuma 42 months imposed a fine of 60000 NIS approximately \$17000 and Maher Dalaysha 42 months imposed a fine of 6000 NIS approximately \$1700.
- Israeli military court sentenced Hiba Abu Rezaq, a resident of Bethlehem to 4 months imposed a fine of 1000 NIS approximately \$277.
