JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound as a result prevented residents and workers including those with entry permits from entering Israeli and Jerusalem. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 16:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:00. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Anata.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) At 20:25, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with residents. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and clashed with residents. (iv) At dawn on June 14th 2013, Israeli forces raided Samir Amis area in north Jerusalem, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and detained 2 residents. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:00 on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces positioned near Qatna village opened fire randomly for alleged fire bombing. (ii) On the evening of June 13th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint opened fire towards a resident and detained him after injuring his leg for allegedly carrying a knife during which Israeli forces clashed with several residents as opened fire and fired tear gas towards Najah Hadib, a resident of Beit Rima leaving her suffocated from tear gas inhalation. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Musa Abu Mohammed near Qalandiya checkpoint. (ii) Israeli forces detained Samer Abu Rameleh and Ahmad Abu Rameleh near Samir Amis area in North Jerusalem. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On June 12th 2013, Israeli forces served notices for the eviction of a parking lot owned by Abu Siyam, Abu Ta'a and Farahan families in an attempt to confiscate the plot of land for allegedly being property of the Israeli Land Authority. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At dawn on June 14th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood and set fire to 2 vehicles inside Abdo car dealership and spray painted racist graffiti onto the outer walls surrounding the car dealership. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 16:00, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross headquarters in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Ein Yabrud bridge. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ein Yabrud village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:45, Israeli forces raided Ramallah until 05:25. (ii) At dawn on June 14th 2013, Israeli forces raided Beit Liqya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Anas Al-Assi in Beit Liqya. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud

JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Arraba. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Amriha village. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Arraba. (iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Qabatiya village, detained 2 residents, temporarily detained Imad Kamil and released him after questioning then withdrew at 06:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Billal Kamil and Salah Al-Din Kamil in Qabatiya. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Tamoun until 05:30.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israel army continues to intensify its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> • Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Kafr Lafiq and Jinsafut and impeded the free flow of traffic until 10:30. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance at Jit junction. (iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the north entrance of Azzun, beneath Azzun bridge and at the entrance of Izbat Al-Tabib village fired tear gas and stun grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:45, Israeli forces raided Azzun, temporarily detained several residents releasing them after questioning then withdrew at 23:40. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum until 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 11:40, Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Nofal, a resident of Qalqiliya as he was reporting to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement. (ii) On January 17th 2013, Israeli forces levelled residential land located at the eastern entrance of Azzun Atma for the purpose of constructing the Wall in the area. (iii) On February 6th 2013, Israeli military bulldozers levelled residential land in Jayyus for the purpose of Wall construction.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 22:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:35, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village as they escorted several Israeli settlers as they stormed archaeological sites in the village then withdrew at 16:15. (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Burin village, clashed with residents then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:20 on June 12th 2013, Israeli forces detained Omar Awad during their raid into Awarta village as mentioned in the previous report. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 13th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Burqa village, handed out several leaflets written in Hebrew stating "This land was mentioned in the Torah and we shall be on it permanently". (ii) At 10:45, an armed Israeli settler forced a taxi to stop under threat of gunpoint and threatened the driver: Raed Fadil during which Israeli forces released the driver at 11:15.

	<p>detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</p> <p>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 12:00. • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> Israeli authorities approved the construction 550 settlement unites on "Brugin" settlement located in North Bruqin on land occupied in 1967. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</p> <p>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</p> <p>(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road between Carmisan and Al-Walaja with cement block.</p> <p>(v) Since June 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Nahhalin village with Road (60) with dirt mounds.</p> • <u>Settlement Activity:</u> On June 13th 2013, the Israeli Minister of Public Works and Housing announced plans for the construction of 1000 settlement unites including 650 unites currently under construction in "Gush Etsiyon" settlement as well as 14 other settlement outposts built on residential owned land in south Beit Jalla occupied in 1967. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <p>(i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.</p> <p>(ii) On May 1st 2013, an Israeli court ruled to halt construction of the wall near Betar village.</p>

HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzaq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Hebron. (ii) At 16:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Ithna junction. (iii) At 17:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Awa. (iv) At 18:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp. (v) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Karnatina area in the old city of Hebron. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Samou', clashed with several residents then withdrew at 13:10. (ii) At 21:50, Israeli forces raided Khursa village, fired tear gas grenades towards a barber shop and detained 2 residents. (iii) At 00:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 04:45. (iv) At 00:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahiriya, stormed and searched several homes, confiscated 3 agricultural tractors owned by Abdallah Abu Allan and Kamal Al-Hawarin then withdrew at 05:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Omar Itbish and Suhayeb Al-Sabar in Khursa village. • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On June 13th 2013, Israeli forces prevented several residents from installing tents in Harbiyat Al-Nabi village located in south Yatta. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles and again on May 21st 2013 Israel forces imposed fishing restriction back to 6 Miles.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.

Detainees Update

On June 13th 2013, Israeli military court in Ofar prison sentenced Alaa Hanaysheh, a resident of Jenin to 10 additional years in prison and imposed a fine of 10,000 NIS approximately \$2770.
