<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:20, Israeli forces positioned near Shufat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 23:30, Israeli forces positioned in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (iii) On the evening of June 13th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in Suna neighbourhood in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Injury:</u> On June 11th 2015, Naela Jum’a was injured after being struck by a tear gas grenades canister fired by Israeli forces during confrontations in Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Liqya

	<p>and detained a resident.</p> <p>(ii) At 16:10, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints near Beit Urr Al-Tahta and Kharbathat Al-Misbah,</p> <p>(iii) At 21:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nabi Salah village junction until 24:00.</p> <p>(iv) At 21:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Um Safa until 23:30.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Qarwat Bani Zeid and summoned Mukhlis Arrar to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Mazara' Nuba village, stormed a home then withdrew at 04:50. (iii) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village, clashed with several residents and as a result killed a resident after opening fire towards him then rammed him with an Israeli Military jeep, which overturned on him and injured Jum'a Salah. (iv) At 07:40, Israeli forces raided Deir Jrier village. • <u>Killing:</u> Israeli forces killed Abdallah Hamayel in Kafr Malik village. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Khalil Qutush (A resident of Jalazoun camp) in Beit Liqya.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Detention:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate "Al-Rihan Gate" detained Muhana Zied (A resident of Ya'bad). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 07:30 on June 13th 2015, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Tayassir checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 20:50, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:10.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Immatin village. (ii) At 14:30 and again at 07:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Hajja village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 19:55, Israeli forces raided the east area of Azzun until 21:20. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:00 on June 12th 2015, Israeli forces temporarily detained an International Peace Activist during a demonstration against the closure of the entrance gate of Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for

	<p>alleged stoning.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 10:45 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint until 22:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:40 and again at 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq until 22:40. (ii) At 20:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan village until 22:40. (iii) At 21:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 21:45. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Ein Beit Al-Ma camp and summoned Mohammad Qattuni (A resident of Ein Beit Al-Ma camp) to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:45. • <u>Land Levelling:</u> At 10:10, Israeli forces stormed Al-Lafha area located in Yanoun village near east Beit Furiq and levelled approximately 10 Dunumes (Acres) of agricultural land and closed the road leading to the land with an earth Mound and cement blocks.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 11:50 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 22:40. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Ariel” settlement and detained a resident. (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Iskaka Village Bridge until 21:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near “Ariel” settlement

	detained Ammar Odwan (A resident of Nablus).
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. • Raid: At 01:35, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed a home then withdrew at 03:00.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:20 on June 13th 2015, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident. (ii) At 11:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp until 12:00. (iii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Yatta, stormed and searched 2 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 05:00 • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Firas Dweik in Hebron. (ii) Israeli forces detained Khaled Al-Arda in Yatta. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, a group of Israeli settler stormed agricultural land in Sweissa village located in east Yatta, chopped off the limbs of several Olive trees owned by Ali Nawaj'a and Shihadeh Nawaj'a then stoned Nasser Nawaj'a as he was video recording the assault. (ii) At 01:35, a group of Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Shuhada road in the old city of Hebron stoned Samer Zahada's home during which Israeli forces temporarily detained the home owner then released him at 02:40

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah and as a result injured a resident as he was attempting to climb the border fence from Rafah. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza and Rafah.

<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is closed. • <u>Attack:</u> At 23:30, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.

GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Closure of Crossing Points: (ii) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (iii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 09:00, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in Al-Buriej and Al-Maghazi camps.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: On the afternoon of June 13th 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards a resident as he was on agricultural land near the border fence in east Khaz'a.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students and businesspersons. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • Attack: At 22:45, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Rafah city. • Detention: At 13:20, Israeli forces positioned in east Al-Nahda neighborhood located in east Rafah detained two unidentified residents after opening fire towards them and as a result, left one residents injured as they were attempting to climb the border fence into Israel.
