JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at checkpoints set up at entrances to the city of Jerusalem and Al Aqsa Mosque. (ii) On 05 January 2009, the Israeli army issued military order # S/02/09 closing the seam line area, an extension of the Wall. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill located in an area between the villages of Biddu and Beit Iksa. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba'. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al Bareed in Jerusalem city from the town of Ar Ram. (iii) On 28 May 2010, the Israeli army closed the eastern entrance to the village of Beit Iksa, which leads to the city of Jerusalem, by an iron gate, and told civilians to pass through Qalandiya checkpoint to Jerusalem city. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and only allows holders of Jerusalem IDs to access the city of Jerusalem. (ii) As of 11 April 2010, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the entrance to Shu'fat refugee camp in the city of Jerusalem and prevent daily civilian traffic access from 23:00 until 05:00. The closure of the checkpoint will continue for a week and half under the pretext of maintenance and setting up an infrastructure between the checkpoint and the road leading to Shu'fat refugee camp. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:10, the Israeli army raided Ar Ram town, positioned troops opposite the town's police station, stormed a number of commercial shops and patrolled the area. (ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Qalandiya refugee camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on al-Shayyah road in the area between the villages of al-Sawahira al-Sharqiya and al-Sawahira al-Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area of al-‘Eizariya to al-Shayyah, from Beit Surik village to Biddu, in the areas of al-Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of al-Jib village, in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna, south of Beit Hanina village, and in the area surrounding the checkpoint set up at the entrance to Shu’fat refugee camp.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village, Safa village and the junction to the villages of Kafr Malik – Ein Samiya. (ii) On 15 March 2010, the Israeli army issued military order declaring the area located between civilian houses and the Wall in the town of Ni’lin and the village of Bil’in as closed military zones from 08:00 until 20:00 every Friday and for a period of 6 months. Civilian access is denied during the mentioned period without a special permit in order to prevent the weekly demonstrations against the Wall. • Raids: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 01:10, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Shuqba. (ii) At 07:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Silwad and arrested 3 civilians. • Arrests: The Israeli army arrested in the town of Silwad the civilians: Wael Mousa Hammad; Majd Basem Hussein Hamad; and Muhammad Abdulrazeq Hamad. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the towns and villages of ‘Abud and Bil’in, and in the areas of al-Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road leading to ‘Arraba town, east of the settlement of Dotan. • Flying Checkpoint: At 17:45, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction leading to Arraba town and searched civilians and vehicles until 18:30. • Raid: At 01:25, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin and its refugee camp. Confrontations took place with civilians while patrolling the area. The Israeli army also took photographs for a number of areas and withdrew at 05:00. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) At 00:15, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Al Far’a refugee camp.

	<p>(iii) At 01:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Tammun, searched a house and arrested a civilian.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested in the town of Tammun the civilian Shafi Najeh Abdulkareem Bsharat.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the road between the town of Kafr Al Labad and the village of Shofeh and the road between the villages of Shofeh and Izbat Shofeh. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify restrictions at Einav checkpoint that is set up on Tulkarm-Nablus main road. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the town of Anabta, searched 2 houses and arrested 2 civilians. (ii) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided the neighborhood of Shuweika in Tulkarm city, searched a house and arrested a civilian. (iii) At 02:10, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Tulkarm city. • Arrests: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested the town of Anabta the civilians Ahmad Fathallah Ibrahim Jadallah and Safwan Najeeb Milhem. (ii) The Israeli army arrested in the neighborhood of Shuweika in Tulkarm city the civilian Adel Muhammad Farid Qaddouha. • Wall Gates: Passage through the wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which affects the educational and health conditions of civilians living behind the Wall.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Azzun. Again at 19:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint and searched civilians and vehicles until 23:20. (ii) At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of An Nabi Elias. (iii) At 19:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Hajja and searched civilians and vehicles until 20:30. (iv) At 20:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Izbat At Tabib village and searched civilians and vehicles until 23:40. • Raid: At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Immatin and searched a house. • Detentions: At 19:00, the Israeli army detained 3 civilians, including a police officer, while on their land that is located north of Kafr Qaddum village. The Israeli army released them at a later time following DCO intervention. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.

	<p>(ii) On 12 May 2010, the Israeli army erected an iron gate at the entrance to the village of Wadi Ar-Rasha (after removing the iron gate erected at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya), and prevented civilians from the village from passing through it. The Israeli army only allows the passage of students to their schools outside the village through Habla town gate, while allowing the passage of civilians through the iron gate # 109.</p>
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the roads of Tel-Burin, Beit Furik-Salem, and the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya; and with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Duma, the eastern entrance to the village of Al Lubban Ash Sharqiya, the western entrances to the town of Aqraba and the village of Majdal Bani Fadil, the northern entrance to the town of Qabalan, as well as the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al-Hatab to Alon Moreh settlement. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close by an iron gate the western entrance to An Naqura village, opposite Shavi Shomron settlement. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut and the road connecting the town of Aqraba to the village of Osarin. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the side road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osarin. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At Tur neighborhood checkpoint (set up on Jerzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighborhood only from 07:00 until 02:00. (ii) Awarta commercial checkpoint is open for civilians from 05:00 until 20:00 and on Friday from 05:00 until 15:00. (iii) At 16:25, the Israeli army closed Huwwara checkpoint and prevented civilian access in both directions after arresting a civilian under the pretext of finding an explosive device in his possession. The Israeli army re-opened the checkpoint at 18:40. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:40, the Israeli army raided Iskar refugee camp in the city of Nablus and arrested 2 civilians. (ii) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled Nablus city. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested 1 unknown civilian at Huwwara checkpoint. (ii) The Israeli army arrested in Iskar refugee camp in the city of Nablus the civilians Hasan Sulaiman Qatanani and Radwan Abdulqader Qatanani.

<p style="text-align: center;">SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the northern entrance to the city of Salfit, and continues to close with cement blocks and iron gates the northern entrance to the town of Bruqin and the western entrance to the town of Kafr Ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impede civilian access. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Biddya. (ii) At 10:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Sarta, occupied the roof of a deserted house and converted it into a military post and patrolled the area. (iii) At 14:45, the Israeli army raided the towns of Bruqin and Kafr Ad Dik where confrontations took place with civilians while patrolling the town of Kafr Ad Dik. The Israeli army withdrew at 01:45. (iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan, searched a house, arrested a civilian and withdrew at 01:45. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested in the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan the civilian Hamzeh Mahmoud Rayyan. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Hares north of the settlement of Ariel.
<p style="text-align: center;">JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of al-'Auja with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at al-Hamra checkpoint and allow civilian access from 06:00 until 22:00. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of al-'Auja and allow access only to civilians holding Jericho and Jordan Valley IDs and those possessing permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:20, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the junction leading to Road # 90 in the middle of Al Auja village. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:10, the Israeli army detained at Al Hamra checkpoint the Palestinian National Security officer Mu'men Muhammad Zakarneh and released him at 15:00 following DCO intervention.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to prevent civilian access to an area that is located in the cities of Beit Sahur and Bethlehem. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads of Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmad, the sideway east of

	<p>Beit Fajjar town and the agricultural road that is located between the town of Taqu'a and the village of Khirbet Al Baq'a.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 10:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on An Nashash area junction (the southern entrance to the city of Bethlehem) and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, the Israeli army raided Al Khadr town. Again at 21:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the area (ii) At 02:55, the Israeli army raided the city of Bethlehem, took photographs for 2 civil police headquarters and Palestinian DCO and arrested a child. (iii) At 04:45, the Israeli army raided Ad-Duheisha refugee camp in the city of Bethlehem, searched a house and served summon to a civilian to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. • <u>Arrest:</u> The Israeli army arrested in the city of Bethlehem 17-year-old Isma'il Khadr Ahmad Masalmeh. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of al-Khadr and Beit Jala city; in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of Ephrata settlement; and in the area surrounding al-Walaja village.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: al-Shuhada' Street and the area of al-Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al-Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of al-Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from al-Laban Market and the area of al-Sahleh. The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to al Laban Market by iron boards. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of al-Hisba in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access in the area. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the area located near the Green Line, south of Yatta town, evacuating the area of those inside it and denying them access to it. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the following locales: the entrance to the town of al-Samoa'; the area of al-Hawawir leading to the town of Halhoul; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of al-Jab'a; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa; the entrance to al-Qeisi neighborhood in the old city of Hebron; the main entrance to al-'Arrub refugee camp; the village of At Tuwani as well as the entrance to the town of Adh Dhahiriya. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from traveling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

As a result, the child sustained serious injuries and evacuated to an Israeli hospital for treatment. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, in the periphery of Eshkolot settlement southwest of Adh Dhahiriya town and between southwest of Arab Ar Ramadin village and the village of Imneizil.

<p style="text-align: center;">ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the Israeli army declared a unilateral ceasefire. In the meantime, armed Palestinian groups declared a one-week-long ceasefire. Meanwhile, the ceasefire was extended until 05 February 2009. The ceasefire is holding despite the end of the specified period. • The Israeli army violated the ceasefire by raiding Palestinian territory, opening fire intensively and firing 4 tank shells in the district of Khan Yunis. The Israeli army also opened fire intensively from its locations on the Green Line in the district of Northern Gaza injuring a child. • Armed Palestinian groups breached the ceasefire by firing 1 mortar towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open for previously coordinated humanitarian cases and foreign nationals. • <u>Attack:</u> In the morning of 14 June 2010, the Israeli army opened fire from its locations on the Green Line towards a number of civilians east of Jabalya town. As a result, 17-year-old child Muhammad Jum'ah Abu Zardah was injured. • <u>Palestinian Attack:</u> In the evening of 14 June 2010, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. (ii) Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing for fuel transport is closed since 04 January 2010 by an Israeli unilateral decision.
