JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beitlksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beitlksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs

<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafir Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village until 13:15. (ii) At 10:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge until 12:20. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:40, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with residents as they searched homes using bomb sniffing dogs after exploding open the main entrance of a home and detained 4 residents. (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Turmus'ayya. (iii) At 20:00, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Abu Falah, stormed a home, confiscated a Lap Top computer then withdrew at 23:30. (iv) At 20:10 and again at 02:30, Israeli forces raided Ramallah, searched 2 homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:50. (v) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Jalazun camp, clashed with residents as they searched a home and as a result Mohammad Al-Ghalith suffocated from tear gas inhalation while they detained a resident and confiscated a computer. (ii) At 10:30, Israeli forces raided Silat Al-Thaher and Al-Yamoun villages until

TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint to between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to increase their restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarm-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 16:35 and again at 04:05, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghsun. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to KafrQaddum village. • Flying Checkpoints: At 16:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Jayyus and Kafr Jamal village. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:50, Israeli forces raided Jayyus. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Eliyas village and stormed several vehicle repair shops. (iii) At 20:345, Israeli forces raided Jit village. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of RasAtiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in KafrLaqif village north of KarneiShomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of KafrThulth town near Ma 'aleShomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of AlonMoreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the

	<p>village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furik. (ii) At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:25, Israeli forces raided Sabastiya village until 23:40. (ii) At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On June 14th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint at Balata camp detained Mohammad Abu Jid and Moath Saleh. (ii) On June 14th 2012, Israeli forces positioned near Huwara detained Mujahid Abdel Nassir. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 04:20, Israeli settlers positioned near Huwara assaulted and injured Muntasir Odeh leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since April 15th 2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses and Ambulances only. The entrance had been closed since the year 2000. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Za'tara checkpoint, detained a resident and impede the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Istiya. • <u>Raid:</u> At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Kafil Harress set up a checkpoint at the entrance, shutdown several merchant shops while protecting Israeli settlers as they raided sites in the area. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area north of DeirIstiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley area and at 17:40 Israeli forces closed the checkpoint as they detained 2 residents for allegedly carrying explosives. (ii) Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Oja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:15 and again at 18:35 on June 14th 2012, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. (ii) At 07:25 on June 14th 2012, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik

BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Baq'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. (ii) Since 14:30 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Taqou with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 09:215, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the western entrance of Taqou until 11:15. • <u>Raid:</u> At 04:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Dhiesheh camp in Bethlehem clashed with residents as they stormed a home. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town.
Hebron	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading between Bani Na'im and Zif village to the entrance to Al-Simiyavillage access to the area. • <u>Raid:</u> At 11:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 13 March 2012 at 01:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis injuring 2 residents. • Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.

<p style="text-align: center;">GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Detention: On the evening of June 14th 2012, Israeli forces detained 3 fishermen off the shores Gaza.
<p style="text-align: center;">KHAN YUNIS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 09:00, Israeli forces escorting bulldozers raided Al-Qarat and Khaz'a. opened fire and launched several artillery shells towards agricultural land as they levelled a plot of land and as a result destroyed several wheat crops and a home owned by Abdallaziz Al-Najjar. • Attack: On the afternoon of June 14th 2012, Israeli forces opened fire from their position behind the Green Line towards Al-Qarara and injured 2 residents. • Palestinian Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the morning of June 14th 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line. (ii) On the afternoon of June 14th 2012, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
