<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces closed a bypass road in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Detention:</u> On June 13th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Beit Ikksa checkpoint detained Mohammad Al-Fuqiya. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 10:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 21:30, Israeli settlers positioned near Bi’er Ayoub area in Silwan neighbourhood opened fire towards a protest tent in the area. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:55, Israeli forces raided Kafr Malik village (for the alleged hurling

	<p>of Molotove fire bomb at an Israeli settler vehicle), clashed with several residents then withdrew at 24:00.</p> <p>(ii) At 03:05, Israeli forces raided Khirbithat Al-Misbah village until 04:00.</p> <p>(iii) At 06:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad, stormed several homes and detained a resident.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Abdel-Hamid Hammad in Silwad. • <u>Provocation of Palestinian Security Forces:</u> At 18:25 on June 14th 2015, Israeli forces positioned beneath Ein Yabrud Village Bridge temporarily seized a Palestinian Police vehicle (despite having prior Security Coordination) and attempted to confiscate the Police officers weapons then were allowed to pass through.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Ya’bad. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin camp, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes, detained three residents and detonated the main gate entrance to the home of Al-Ghoul family and as a result damaged several pieces of home furniture and assaulted Jum’a Al-Ghoul and temporarily detained Ahmad Al-Qaniri then released him later. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Suhayeb Al-Ghoul, Farouk Salameh and Yahya Balloul in Jenin camp. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 05:05, Israeli forces raided Khirbiet Attouf village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned at wall gate (623) located in Deir Al-Ghusoun temporarily detained Mohammad Ghanam (A resident of Deir Al-Ghusoun) then released him at 20:30. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed residential land located in the area between Kafr Al-Labbad and Izbit Shufa villages then withdrew at 15:00.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya. (ii) At 17:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Izbit Al-Tabib and Assalah village until 19:00. (iii) At 18:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun until 21:05. (iv) At 19:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Immatin

	<p>village until 20:20.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village temporarily detained two children: Yusef Ali (17 years old) and Wasef Ali (17 years old) then released them later and withdrew at 22:00. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 12:15. (ii) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beita until 11:00. (iii) At 09:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Orif village • <u>Raid:</u> At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Baraka area located near Tel village until 16:05.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 15:45 and again at 01:20, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 02:00. • <u>Detention:</u> At 09:45 on June 14th 2015, Israeli forces positioned near “Kiryat Natavim” settlement located in West Harris village detained Osama Al-Lafi (A resident of Bidya).
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nuwe’meh village junction located at the north entrance of Jericho until 09:40.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the

village.

- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• **Flying Checkpoint:**

- (i) At 09:00 and again at 17:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Nashash area junction (located at the south entrance of Bethlehem) until 18:00.
- (ii) At 11:55 and again at 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in Ush Al-Ghurab area located in east Beit Sahur until 15:10.
- (iii) At 14:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement junction, detained a resident and temporarily detained Hani Amro then released him later.
- (iv) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Jallah until 05:00.

- **Raid:** At 11:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Faradis village, stormed a stone carving workshop and confiscated several carving tools owned by Ahmad Al-Tuwarat and forced him to cease work in the area along the main road leading to Al-Faradis Mountain.

- **Detention:** At 22:50, Israeli forces positioned at a checkpoint near "Kafr Itsiyon" settlement junction detained Mohammad Al-Jahalin (A resident of Al-Khader).

- **Temporary Detention:** At 22:50, Israeli forces temporarily detained Amminah Manasrah who was accompanied by her infant son (residents of Al-Khader) as she was visiting her husband in Israeli prison (Ashil).

• **Destruction of Property:**

- (i) On the morning of June 15th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Ein Al-Hawa

	<p>area located in Husan village and uprooted several Olive trees on approximately 20 dunums (acres) of land owned by Ibrahim Shusha and Adel Shusha claiming that the land is owned by the State of Israel.</p> <p>(ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces stormed Faradis village and demolished a barracks (used as a car wash) owned by Hashim Abu Mahamadin.</p>
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:00 on June 15th 2015, Israeli forces detained Wael Shamroukh (A Palestinian Police Officer) during their raid into Al-Urub cam as mentioned in the previous. (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Shouqi Masauda in the old city of Hebron. • Temporary Detention: At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar temporarily detained Mohammad Al-Za'ariq, his wife and his 5-year-old son then released them later.

<p>ALL DISTRICTS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • The Israeli Military broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iyah (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several Sheppard's herding their goats on agricultural land in east Al-Zaytouneh neighbourhood located in south east Gaza city.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students and businesspersons. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
