JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> On June 16th 2013, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and detained a University Student. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ribhi Sinuqrut in Abu Dis. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On June 16th 2013, Israeli forces forced Hassan Houdan to demolish 25m² of his home and imposed a fine of 30000 NIS approximately \$8300 for allegedly being built without proper licencing. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> On the morning of June 16th 2013, Israeli settlers, under the protection of Israeli forces, stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On June 15th 2013, Israeli settlers assaulted 2 residents: Laila Al-Sayad, a resident of Jabal Al-Tur leaving her hospitalised with a broken nose and Anwar Abu Ramouz, a resident of Silwan leaving her hospitalised with contusions. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic

	<p>devices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamun until 10:00. (ii) At 17:50, Israeli forces raided Bruqin until 19:30. (iii) At 21:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village. (iv) At 22:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Jamatat village until 01:30. (v) At 22:10, Israeli forces raided the village of Beit Qad until 23:00. (vi) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Meithalun. (vii) At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Faqu'a and stormed a home. TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area. • Raid: At 21:40, Israeli forces raided Ibziq village until 23:10. • Detention: At 14:30, Israeli forces detained Mo'ayad Foqaha, a resident of Ein Al-Bayda as he was working in the Jordan valley.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: At 08:45, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Irtah neighbourhood in Tulkarem until 10:30. (ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Baqa Al-Sharqiya, set up a checkpoint, stormed 2 homes and a coffee shop then withdrew at 22:30. (iii) At 22:55, Israeli forces raided Zeita, set up a checkpoint until 23:15. (iv) At 00:30, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:20. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services

QALQILIYA	<p>for civilians living behind the Wall.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 08:25 and again at 16:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village and summoned Ayman Hammad to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 11:05, Israeli forces raided Azzun Atma. (iii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Azzun, fired flash grenades then withdrew at 00:45. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:20, Israeli forces temporarily detained 3 residents: Sa'id Suliman, Muhsin Majd and Mohammad Salim near Wadi Qana and released them at a later time. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

	<p>22:00.</p> <p>(ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Nablus and Balata camp, stormed several homes, and detained 4 residents including 2 National Security officers and a child.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Anas Hamad (17 years old), Hassan Hashash, Mujahid Abu Zur and Mohammad Abu Zur in Balata camp in Nablus. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <p>(i) At 13:45, Israeli settlers stormed Al-Mas'udiya area near Burqa, performed Talmudic rituals then withdrew at 14:30.</p> <p>(ii) At 19:00, Israeli settlers stormed Asira Al-Qibliya under the protection of Israeli forces that fired tear gas grenades towards residents as they attempted to prevent the settler assault then withdrew at 19:45.</p>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.</p> <p>(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:15, Israeli forces raided Rafat village until 24:00. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces closed Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</p> <p>(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.</p> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.</p> <p>(iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.</p> <p>(iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.</p>

	<p>(v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.</p> <p>(vi) Since 11:30 on June 8th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near “Ush Al-Ghurab” area located West of Beit Sahur until 20:20. • <u>Raid:</u> At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Khadr until 19:55. • <u>Detention:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in the area between Al-Ayda camp and “Gilo” settlement detained 4 children, residents of Al-Ayda: Ehab Abu Hamad (16 years old), Ali Sarour (16 years old), Sarour Abu Sarour (16 years old) and Muhanad Abu Sarour (16 years old). • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town. (ii) On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
<p>HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada’ Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron’s Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa’ towns, Al-‘Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron’s Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou’ and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou’ village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul bridge. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints in Sinjir area located between Hebron and Dura. (iii) At 12:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Kahil. (iv) At 13:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nabi Yunis area along the main road connecting Hebron and Bethlehem. (v) At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Farsh Al-Hawa area located in North Hebron.

(ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Al-Basa area in Ithna, set up a checkpoint and stormed several homes. (iii) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Kursiya village. (iv) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron and set up a checkpoint. (v) At 01:25, Israeli forces raided Beit Awa. (vi) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Shalabi Al-Zibadi in Dura. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement after raiding and opened fire towards North Gaza.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:50 on June 13th 2013, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed 300 m into the vicinity of Abu Samara area located in north Beit Lahiya and opened fire towards agricultural land then withdrew at 11:00 on June 14th 2013.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
KHAN YUNIS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> On the evening of June 16th 2013, Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Musalim Abu Muharib, Walid Abu Muharib, Khalid Abu Muharib and Hamza Abu Surin.

RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u>• Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed.• Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits.• Sufa Crossing is closed.• Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination and allowed 20 truckloads of humanitarian goods.
