JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free the flow of traffic. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Raid:</u> On the afternoon of June 16th 2014, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya, demolished a vegetable shop and a car wash located near "Malee Adumin" settlement owned by Sami Abu Ghaliya for allegedly being built without a licence. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On June 15th 2014, Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Ahed Alqam and Mohammad Alqam in Shu'fat camp in Jerusalem. (ii) At 14:45, Israeli forces detained Rashid Za'rour (A resident of Jenin) in Jerusalem • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces positioned near "Koghav Yacoub" settlement located in east Kafr Aqab opened fire towards several children for alleged stoning and as a result critically injured the child Yazen Yacoub with gunshot wound to the chest. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Beit Safafa village stoned residents and vehicles. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

(iii) At 04:00 on June 16th 2014, Israeli forces raided Marka village, stormed and searched 3 homes and damaged a vehicle owned by Samir Musa. (iv) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Jenin and its camps, occupied 3 homes owned by :Mahmoud Abu Na'sa, Hassan Awad and Mahmoud Abu Ghaliyou and converted their rooftops into Military posts during which they clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and as a result injured 2 residents: Thaher Yassin and Ahmad Aqtish and Israeli forces assaulted and injured Anas Suqiya, damaged furniture as they searched 7 homes owned by: Ahmad Awartani, Ahmad Akl-Najar, Awni Abu Aliya, Thiyab Sa'ed, Abu Sa'ed Al-Balawi, Rajeh Abu Aliya and his father's home during which Israeli forces also detained 8 residents including a Palestinian Intelligence officer and an Attorney. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Osama Al-Shallabi and Ibrahim Abu Khier in Al-Silah Al-Harthiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Wissam Ghawarda in Bir Al-Basha village.

	<p>(iii) Israeli forces detained 8 residents: Abdallah Al-Sa'diu (a Palestinian Intelligence officer), Yazen Jarar (an Attorney), Mohammad Sa'ed, Wael Turkman, Kifah Khadr, Yusef Al-Teter, Ahmad Samara and Ibrahim Masalmeh in Jenin.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Confiscation of Property: At 02:15 on June 16th 2014, Israeli forces confiscated several files and 3 computers after storming and searching the Emirates business association, Al-Bar'a Foundation and The National Initiative organisation in Jenin. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:0, Israeli forces raided the area located between Bal'a and Deir Al-Ghusun until 21:00. (ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusun.

(iii) At 21:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village with dirt mounds. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. (ii) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun Atma village • Raid: At 21:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes and occupied Wajdi Salamehs home and converted its rooftop into a military post, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 04:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Murad Salim , Waleed Salim and Wahid Salim in Azzun. • Temporary Detention: At 12:10, Israeli forces positioned at "Ayel" checkpoint located along the Green Line in north Qalqiliya temporarily detained Ali Awisat (An Attorney) then released him after assaulting and injuring him. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Checkpoint: At 07:15, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Huwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beir Furiq • Raid: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Nasiriya village as they escorted several lab technicians from the Israel water authority as they tested several water wells then withdrew at 12:30. (iv) At 02:40, Israeli forces raided Orif village until 05:20. (v) At 03:35, Israeli forces raided Yatma village, stormed a home and detained a resident. 	Ormoma” settlement in Burin village then withdrew at 12:30.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • Checkpoints: At 07:15, Israeli forces closed Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Raid: At 20:05, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 21:00. • Detention: At 21:15, Israeli forces positioned at Z’atar checkpoint detained Amjad Al-Himshari, a resident of Tulkarem. • Attack: At 05:40, Israeli forces positioned near Harris village opened fire towards Hamada Suf (A Special needs patient) leaving him hospitalised with gunshot wounds to the legs. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: Since 19:45 on June 13th 2014, The Israeli military declared the Dead Sea area as a closed military area after alleging the abduction of 3 Israeli settlers • Checkpoints: Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho until 12:30. (ii) At 14:55, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Ein Dweik village located in north Jericho until 16:00. • Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) AT 16:20, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge detained Saji Abu Athba, a resident of Jericho as he was travelling to Jordan. (ii) At 19:55, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby Bridge detained Khather Abdel-Rahman (A resident of Nablus) for allegedly carrying knife as he was travelling to Jordan. • Settler Violence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 15:40, Israeli settlers positioned along the main road connecting Jericho city and Al-Oja stoned residents and vehicles. (ii) At 15:40, Israeli settlers butchered 2 goats owned by Odeh Ka’abneh, a resident of Al-Oja village.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu’mān village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu’mān: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road

between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near “Ifrat” settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.

- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to “Newe Daniyyel” settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za’tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub’a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

 - (iii) At 20:15, Israeli forces raided Jorat Al-Sham’a, Um Salmuna and Wadi Al-Nis villages , stormed several homes and merchant shops, confiscated surveillance tapes of a merchant shop in Jorat Al-Sham’a and set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 20:40.
 - (iv) At 23:45, Israeli forces raided Nihalin village , stormed a home and several merchant shops, confiscated surveillance tapes from the merchant store and set up a checkpoint.
 - (v) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Ayda camp, stormed a home and destroyed the front door of a Charity foundation headquarters and confiscated several computers and files, detained a resident, assaulted and injured Ahmad Odeh leaving him hospitalised with contusions.
