<p style="text-align: center;">JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) At 11:00, Israeli forces closed a bypass road in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:55, Israeli forces set up two checkpoints at the east and west entrances of Al-Eisawiya village. • <u>Raid:</u> At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Anata then stormed and searched a home. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 21:30, Israeli forces positioned in Wadi Al-Juz neighbourhood temporarily detained the child Rami Al-Tamimi then released him later. • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

(ii) At 14:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in

	<p>North Bir Ziet.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, stormed a home and summoned Ali Al-Qurt to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 16:00. (ii) At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Um Safa village until 00:30. (iii) At 05:00, Israeli forces raided Silwad, detained 2 residents including a child then withdrew at 06:15. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained two residents: Abdel-Hamid Hamad (17 years old) and Badi' Hamad in Silwad.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Abu Da'if village until 12:40. (ii) At 15:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Dan village until 16:55. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da'if village until 13:50. (ii) At 14:15, Israeli forces raided Kafr Dan village until 15:00. (iii) At 03:45, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 04:45. (iv) At dawn on June 17th 2015, Israeli forces raided Bruqin and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Jarrar in Bruqin. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Al-Bithan and Al-Far'a villages until 16:55. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 06:00 on June 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Al-Thaghra area located in east Tubas, levelled agricultural land and as a result uprooted hundreds of trees planted by the Palestinian Ministry of agriculture. (ii) At 04:10, Israeli forces raided Tayasir village and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Hillal Subieh in Tayasir village.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 16:55, Israeli forces detained Fadi Khattab (A resident of Tulkarem) as he was attempting to cross into Israel in order to obtain a workers permit.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On June 16th 2015, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya and detained a resident. (ii) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Azzun, stormed and searched a home and detained a

	<p>resident.</p> <p>(iii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Thulth, stormed and searched a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:25.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces detained Walid Odeh in Qalqiliya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Ussayed Sal; eem in Azzun. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ayham Gharabah in Kafr Thulth. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma’in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Furiq, temporarily detained two residents: Basil Yassin (A resident of Assirah Al-Shimaliya) and Abed Nassasrah then released them at 20:20. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burqa village junction and impeded the free flow of traffic for the alleged hurling of a firebomb towards and Israeli Military vehicle near the village then withdrew at 22:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Furiq, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 11:20. (ii) At 12:25, Israeli forces raided Rujieb village then stormed and searched a merchant shop. (iii) At 20:30, Israeli forces raided Beita, stormed a home and detained a resident. (iv) At 02:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus until 04:40. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Firas Farahat in Beita. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces stormed Sarah village and served a military order for the demolition and removal of an Electrical Generator and network located on the east side of the village for allegedly being built without a licence because of its location in Area C {which is under Israeli Military and Administrative control}.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from

	<p>08:00 until 09:20.</p> <p>(iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:35, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:40, Israeli forces positioned near Za'tara checkpoint junction detained Mohammad Qarrad {A National Security Force Officer} (A resident of Askar Camp in Nablus). • <u>Land Levelling:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On June 15th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Al-Balat area in Kafr Al-Dik village and levelled a plot of land approximately 100 m² and uprooted several trees owned by Najjah Hamad {A resident of Kafr Al-Dik}. (ii) On June 15th 2015, Israeli forces stormed Kafil Harris village and demolished a car wash owned by Ghannam Daoud.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 16:00, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:45, Israeli forces raided Aqaba camp in Jericho, stormed a home, summoned Thiyab Odeh (A National Security Force officer) to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:20.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of

(ii) At 13:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Al-Khader Bridge (located along the main road connecting the west village in the district) until 14:50. • <u>Raid:</u> At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed a home, detained a resident then withdrew at 03:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Al-Amour in Taqou'.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 10:30. (ii) At 20:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Sa'ir. • <u>Raid:</u> At 10:00 and again at 23:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron city.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month. • The Israeli Military broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza.

NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businesspersons and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. • <u>Detention:</u> At 12:30, Israeli forces detained an unidentified resident after opening fire towards him and injuring his legs as he was attempting to climb the border fence into Israel.
GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:30, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards agricultural land in east Al-Maghazi camp.
RAFAH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the entry and exit of residents, students and businesspersons. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of tourist and foreign diplomats and the entry of Humanitarian assistance and construction material funded by UNRWA.
