JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continue to increase its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikxa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikxa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. • <u>Home Demolition:</u> On June 17th 2012, Israeli authorities forced Sharif Qaniya to demolish his home and farm in addition to financial penalty for allegedly not

	<p>having required licencing in Biet Ikka.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village as well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • Flying Checkpoint: At 01:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit El settlement junction located in north Al-Bireh. • Raid: At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Nabi Saleh village and searched 2 homes. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Araba and impeded the free flow of traffic until 14:00. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Anza village. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces raided Hajja village. (iii) At 11:50, Israeli forces raided Araba village. (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Jenin until 02:40. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to increase its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint, seized several residents' cellular phones to contact Israeli intelligence officers, detained Eyas Harashata realising him at a later time between the hours of 06:00 and 22:00.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army increased its restrictions at Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Flying Checkpoint: At 20:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces raided Itrah neighbourhood in Tulkarem until 10:05. (ii) At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Far'un village. (iii) At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Atil, searched several homes then withdrew at 03:10. (iv) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Shwiekiya neighbourhood in Tulkarem, searched several homes, detained a child then withdrew at 05:00. • Detention: Israeli forces detained As'ad Na'ula (17 years) during their raid into

	<p>Tulkarem.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land leveling for adjustment of the Wall route resumed in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route is to be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Immatin village, seized and searched a bus carrying Palestinian Police officers and allowed them to pass through at a later time. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:55, Israeli forces raided Kafr Laqif. (ii) At 23:55, Israeli forces raided Immatin village, searched 3 homes then withdrew at 01:50. • Settler Violence: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli settlers raided and set fire to agricultural land owned by Abdel Raziq Amar in Kafr Qaddum, destroying several crops before Palestinian civil defence forces could put out the fire. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli settler's vehicle ran over and injured Mohammad Al-Basha (13 years) on the main road near Al-Funduq village leaving him hospitalised with contusions. • Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:55 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction. (ii) At 16:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Sarah village junction. (iii) At 02:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Shave Shomron settlement junction. • Raids: At 01:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Nassriya village. • Settler Violence: At 12:45, Israeli settlers raided agricultural land in Yanun

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:05, Israeli forces continue to increase their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint until 14:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 13:05 and again at 02:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Zawiya, searched several homes, detained 2 residents then withdrew at 04:30. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Khalil Abu Baker and Abdel Hakim Shqir during their raid into Al-Zawiya. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between Jericho city and Al-Oja village with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to restrict access through Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts, only allowing access to residents of Jericho District and the Jordan Valley. (ii) At 22:20, Israeli forces increased its restrictions to access at the checkpoint set up on the junction to Al-Ouja village, only allowing access to residents of the Jericho District and others with access permits. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance of Jericho. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Jericho while protecting Israeli settlers as they raided a synagogue then withdrew at 12:05. (ii) At 03:10, Israeli forces raided Aqbat Al-Jabir camp in Jericho, stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04:35. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Sa'ed Awish in Aqbat Al-Jabir camp.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

(ii) At 10:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Husan village until 12:05. (iii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the western entrance of Beit Jalla until 18:50. (iv) At 18:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Al-Khadr until 20:35 • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed northwest of Beit Jala town.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to the entrance to Al-Simiya village. (v) At 17:15, Israeli forces closed the southern entrance leading in Al-Samou' with dirt mounds and cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar until 10:35. (ii) At 11:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Fuwwar junction. (iii) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction. (iv) At 12:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Majd village. (v) At 13:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Khursa village junction. (vi) At 01:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Abu Hadid area in Hebron until 05:40. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:15 and again at 01:35, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained 2 residents. (ii) At 12:05, Israeli forces raided Khilat Saleh area located in Yatta. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Shadi Qawasmeh and Mohammad Abdien in Hebron. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 11:00, an Israeli settler opened fire towards and killed 2 residents in Al-Samou'. • <u>Killing:</u> An Israeli settler opened fire towards and killed Anwar Abed Rabbo and Na'im Al-Najjar in Al-Samou'. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North and Central Gaza. • Israeli military Helicopters opened fire towards Gaza and Rafah. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats and confiscated their fishing boats off the shores of central Gaza and Rafah.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Raid: At 06:30, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers raided 400 meters into the vicinity of Beit Hanun and opened fire as they levelled a plot of agricultural land. • Attack: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:30, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Beit Lahiya, detained 4 fishermen and confiscated their fishing boat. (iii) At 22:15, Israeli forces opened fire towards a home near the vicinity of Beit Hanun crossing. (iv) At 05:00, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen of the shores of Beit Lahiya. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Matar, Mohammad Suri, Ashraf Sa'dallah and Mohammad Sa'dallah off the shores of Beit Lahiya.

Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. • Aerial Assault: On the evening of June 17th 2012, Israeli aircrafts fired 2 missiles towards Palestinian gunmen in Gaza city.
<p style="text-align: center;">Central Gaza</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Raid: At 08:20, Israeli forces escorting military bulldozers raided and opened fire agricultural land in Wadi Salaqa, injured a resident as they levelled a plot of land which resulted in the destruction of agricultural harvests, irrigation pipe lines, a water well then withdrew at 16:20.
<p style="text-align: center;">Khan Yunis</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack: At 02:00 on June 17th 2012 and again at 03:00 on June 18th 2012, Israeli naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Khan Yunis.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAFAH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Points: • Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. • Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, and passengers with permits. • Sufa Crossing is closed. • Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, 30 truckloads of wheat and Livestock
