JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 45 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikka villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- (iii) At 18:00, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Jaba' checkpoint located along the road connecting Jerusalem, Ramallah and Jericho and impeded the free the flow of traffic.
- **Checkpoints:**
 - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic, closed the checkpoint at 17:00 then reopened it at a later time.
 - (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:**
 - (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Ijza village, stormed and searched several homes then withdrew at 12:30.
 - (ii) At 19:00, Israeli forces raided Al-Isawiya and detained child.
- **Detention:**
 - (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Za'im checkpoint detained 3 residents: Hisham Abidein (A resident of Al-Eizariya), Nur Kamal Abidien (A resident of Beit Hanina) and Nur Assad Al-Abidien (A resident of Beit Hanina).
 - (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained, Mahmoud Al-Jindi, a resident of Jerusalem as he was near Al-Masqubiya Military base after being assaulted by Israeli forces.
 - (iii) At 12:00, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint detained Mohammad Sikawi, a resident of Qalandiya camp.
 - (iv) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained 6 residents {of which include former detainees previously released in the Gilad Shalit prisoner swap deal with Israel}: Ibrahim Mash'al, Ismail Hijari, Jamal Abu Saleh, Rajjab Tahan, Adnan Marghat, and Aladdin Bazayin in Jerusalem.
 - (v) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained Nassar Dawit {a former detainee previously released in the Gilad Shalit prisoner swap deal with Israel}.
 - (vi) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Sayima (17 years old) in Al-Isawiya village
- **Temporary Detention:** At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint temporarily detained Osama Akhalil (A Palestinian Police Officer) as he was returning with his ill wife from Al-Maqqassid hospital for alleged expiration of his entry permit into Israeli then released him at 20:30.
- **Land Levelling:** At 12:00, Israeli bulldozers stormed Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem and levelled a plot of land approximately 0.5 dunumes (acres) which is owned by Samir Shaqir.
- **Assault on Places of Worship:**
 - (i) At 09:00, Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound as they were escorting Israeli Archaeologists through the site.
 - (ii) At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound and provoked worshippers.
- **Settler Violence:** At 11:00, Israeli settlers positioned near Silwan neighbourhood stoned residents and vehicles and as a result damaged several vehicles.

(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
