DISTRICT	EVENT	
ALL DISTRICTS	Since 22 March 2004, the Israeli army has imposed a total closure over the West Bank and Gaza Strip. The Israeli army prevented civilians from crossing the Green Line and entering Jerusalem, closed crossing points to workers, and restricted movement between cities in the West Bank.	

WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the city, closing all roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Worshipers from other districts were not allowed pass the checkpoints to pray in the Aqsa mosque, forcing many worshipers to pray at checkpoints. Wall Construction: Wall construction was suspended for the weekend in Al Eizariya, Abu Dis, Al Sawahira al Sharqiya, Sur Bahir, Qatanna, Biddu, along the main road between Dahiyat Al Bareed checkpoint and Qalandiya checkpoint, and near Qalandiya airport. Arrests: The Israel army arrested 143 workers in the city of Jerusalem and Ashdud, interrogated them and referred them to court to be tried for entering Jerusalem without permits.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: Construction of the western portion of the Wall was suspended for the weekend in Budrus, Deir Qaddis, Rantis, Ni'lin, Beit Liqya, Beituniya, and near the village of Midya. Raids: At 22:00, an Israeli jeep raided the village of Kafr 'Ein, fired sound bombs and tear gas, and patrolled the area. At 22:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawat Bani Zeid. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. The Israeli army withdrew at 23:00. At 01:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Arura and opened indiscriminate fire.

	 (iv) At 04:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah, stopped a vehicle belonging to the Palestinian National Security and detained an officer until 05:40. Detention: At 07:30, the Israeli army set up a checkpoint on the Ramallah/Bir Zeit road near the village of Abu Qash, detained hundreds of vehicles and delayed civilians from reaching their destinations.
JENIN	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall was suspended for the weekend south of Jalbun towards Al Mutilla, Raba, Al Mughayyir, Bardala and 'Ein al Beida and towards the Jordan River. Raids: At 12:00, the Israeli army raided the village of Jalqamus and detonated a cave, setting fire to 50 dunums (12.5 acres) of olive trees. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Meithalun, searched a number of houses and arrested 2 civilians. The Israeli army withdrew at 04:00. At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Jenin, searched a number of houses and arrested a civilian. The Israeli army withdrew at 04:30. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians from the town of Meithalun: Dirar Yusif Nu'eirat; and Salih Nu'eirat. The Israeli army arrested Tawfiq Mustafa Samara from the city of Jenin.
JERICHO	Closure: The Israeli army set up dozens of checkpoints throughout the city, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and prevented civilians from crossing.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing civilians from crossing. The Israeli army continues to close the only road leading to the village of Al Nu'man, northeast of the Bethlehem district, isolating the village and placing it under the jurisdiction of the Jerusalem municipality. Wall Construction: Construction of the Wall was suspended for the

	 weekend north of the district of Bethlehem, west of Wadi Hilwa, near the Armenian monastery, on the Jerusalem-Bethlehem road and along the tunnel road (Gilo) and road #60- Husan. Raid: At 17:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Ubeidiya and patrolled the area.
TULKAREM	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Attack: At 21:30, the Israeli army opened indiscriminate fire from the area surrounding the settlement of Evne Hefets near the village of Kafa. Raids: At 09:05, an Israeli army jeep raided the town of Kafr Al Labad and patrolled the area. At 20:10, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem and its suburbs, took position in different neighbourhoods, opened indiscriminate fire and arrested a civilian. At 21:15, an Israeli army jeep raided the Tulkarem refugee camp. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, injuring 3 civilians, including a child and a woman. At 01:10, the Israeli army opened fire again. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Muhammad Khalil Al Sahar from Tulkarem.
NABLUS	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Raid: At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and Asker refugee camp and arrested 2 individuals, including a member of the Palestinian National Security. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 individuals from the city of Nablus and the refugee camp of Asker: (i) Ala Awwad; and (ii) Khamis Muhammad Al Ahwal. At 16:00, the Israeli army at the checkpoint of Huwwara arrested eid Said Al Miskawi.

HEBRON	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Raids: At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, and patrolled several neighbourhoods. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Dura and patrolled the area. Physical Assault: The Israeli army at Al Shuhada street in Hebron city raided a house and severely beat a family of 25 members, following which a number were hospitalized. Settler Violence: At 17:00, a settler vehicle, travelling on the settler bypass road in the town of Beit Ummar, ran over a family of 3 (father, mother, and child) and fled without transporting the injured to hospital.
QALQILYA	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing all entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The closure continues to negatively impact education, economic and livelihood activities and impede access to health facilities. Physical Assault: At 17:00, the Israeli army located at the checkpoint near the village of Habla severely beat Qahira Muheisin, a 42 year old woman, following which she was hospitalized.
SALFIT	 Closure: The Israeli army set up flying checkpoints throughout the district, closing dozens of entrances to the city and roads connecting towns and villages, and preventing pedestrians and vehicles from crossing. Wall Construction: The Israeli army suspended work on land levelling west of the village of Iskaka and north of the city of Salfit in preparation for construction of a fence around the settlement of Ariel as part of the Wall. Demonstration: At 10:30, a mass demonstration against the Wall, in which international peace activists participated, took place in the villages of Al Iskaka and Al Zawiya. Confrontations erupted between the Israeli army and civilians in which the Israeli army fired live ammunition at a number of civilians, setting fire to olive trees, and fired tear gas causing gas inhalation by a number of demonstrators. Civilians held Friday noon prayers on their land on which the Wall construction is taking place. Raids/Curfews: At 19:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Salfit, opened

indiscriminate fire and patrolled the area until 24:00.

(ii) At 20:45, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Iskaka and imposed curfew. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, in which the Israeli army fired tear gas causing gas

inhalation by a number of civilians.

- (iii) At 20:50, the Israeli army raided the village of Yasuf and imposed curfew.
- (iv) At 21:20, the Israeli army raided the villages of Al Laban ash Sharqi and Ammuriya and patrolled the area.
- <u>Detention</u>: At 23:00, the Israeli army at the checkpoint at the Qabalan village junction detained 2 civilians until 02:00.
- <u>Air Patrol</u>: At 21:20, Israeli helicopters patrolled the skies over the city of Salfit and its surrounding villages.

GAZA STRIP

NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure</u>: Beit Hanun crossing is partially open to merchants only. <u>Raid</u>: Since 18:35 yesterday, the Israeli army held positions 400 meters into Palestinian territory near Point 27, in the area north of the town of Beit Hanun. It levelled agricultural land for the construction of a 100 meter road west of Point 28, and withdrew at 19:50.
GAZA CITY	 Closure: The junction of Nitsareem remains closed. Al Mintar crossing is closed. Attack: At 08:35, the Israeli army opened fire from a watch tower located east of Al Shuhada junction towards a Palestinian National Security location. Air Raid: At 23:10, the Israeli army fired missiles at 2 blacksmith workshops, one of which was located in the area of Asqula and the other in the neighbourhood of Al Zeitun in Gaza city.
CENTRAL GAZA	Activities not yet reported.
KHAN YUNIS	 Closure: (i) Abu al Ajin road (Khan Yunis Al Sharqiya) remains closed. (ii) Western road (Khan Yunis) remains closed. (iii) Al Mawasi/Khan Yunis road (Al Tuffah checkpoint) is closed. (iv) Abu Holi road is closed.
