	Closure: On June 15 th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local
	residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the
JERUSALEM	entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. Checkpoints: Israeli army continues their restrictions on Palestinian access at 'Einav checkpoint on the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Flying Checkpoint: At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village. Raid: (i) At dawn on June 18th 2012, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghsun, detained a resident and confiscated a computer. (ii) At 23:40, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem and its camps, clashed with residents **TULKAREM** then withdrew at 03:00. **Detention:** (i) At 03:10 on June 18th 2012, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Shawarki (17 years), Husam Na'wala (17 years) and Mohammad Nafiya. (ii) Israeli forces detained Asad Badran in Deir Al-Ghsun. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. **Wall Construction:** Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village. **Closure of Roads:** (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second *Intifada*, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. **Flying Checkpoint:** (i) At 09:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinsafut village. (ii) At 13:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Wadi Qana area. (iii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Oalgilva. (iv) At 19:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. Raid: At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Qalqilya, stormed a home and detained a resident. **Detention:** (i) At 13:40, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Da'as as he was allegedly attempting to cross the border into Israeli without a permit. **QALQILYA** (ii) Israeli forces detained Ali Milhim. Settlement Activity: At 18:30, Israeli authorities paved a road near Qaddumim settlement on land located in Kafr Qaddum. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the (ii) village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road east of Beit Fajjar town; the road connecting Tuqu' town to Khirbet al Bag'a village; and the detour road connecting Wadi Fukin and Al Jab'a villages. (ii) Since 14:30 on January 10th 2012, the Israeli army closed a road leading to Tuqu' with dirt mounds. Flying Checkpoints: At 15:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Tagou. (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Khadr. (ii) Raids: (i) At 13:15, Israeli forces raided Za'tara area inAl-Ubeidiya, demolished several residential tents and 2 barracks owned by Mohammad Sarhan and Nayef Sarhan for allegedly not having proper licencing. At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Tagou', stormed several homes, detained 5 residents including a child then withdrew at 04:00. At 04:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Dhishiya camp in Bethlehem, clashed with residents as they stormed several homes, detained a resident then withdrew at 04.40**Detention:** (i) Israeli forces detained Ibrahim Al-Sabah (17 years), Hamza Qawazna, Mohammad Qawazna, Alaa Qawazna and Ahmad Al-Dabah in Taqou. (ii) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Zaghari in Bethlehem. **Demonstration:** At 10:20, a demonstration took place in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. Wall Construction: Wall construction continued northwest of Beit Jala town. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the (ii) Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-(i) Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as (iii) Hebron detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to (iv) the entrance to Al-Simiya village. Since 17:15 on June 17th 2012, Israeli forces continue to close the southern (v)

entrance to Al-Samou' with dirt mounds.

• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bani Na'im.

• Raids:

- (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Dura.
- (ii) At 11:00 and again at 23:40, Israeli forces raided Hebron and detained a resident.
- (iii) At 13:45, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar, served 4 demolition orders for homes owned by Mohammad Maqbul, Khalil Khatib, Mohamamd Salama and Jawad Al-Za'qiq for allegedly being built without proper licencing because of their location in Area C which is under Israeli Administrative and military control.
- (iv) At 18:00, Israeli forces raided Marah Al-Baqr village and searched a chicken farm.
- (v) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Yatta.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Shafiq Saqafi in Hebron.
- Home Demolition: On June 18th 2012, Israeli forces served demolition orders for 4 residential tents and an Electric generator owned by Ibrahim Zien, Omar Abu Jundiya, Ibrahim Abu Jundiya and Ali Zien in Yatta.
- <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continued in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahiriya town.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 02:00 on 18 January 2009, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards North Gaza. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by firing tank artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza and Central Gaza. Israeli aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching 6 missiles towards North and Central Gaza which resulted in the killing of 6 Palestinian gunmen and another critically injured. Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 11 projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. Raid: Since 06:30 on June 18th 2012, Israeli forces continued raiding and opening fire towards agricultural land as they escorting bulldozers as they levelled plots of Land in Beit Hanun until 12:10. Aerial Assault: At 10:45, Israeli aircrafts launched missiles towards a motorcycle carrying 2 Palestinian gunmen near Beit Hanun and killed them. At 18:10, Israeli aircrafts launched missiles towards 3 Palestinian gunmen near Beit Hanun crossing killing 2 and critically injuring another. Killing: Israeli forces killed Mohammad Shabat and Mohammad Abu Odeh during air strikes on Beit Hanun. Israeli forces killed Abdallah Za'tarin and Mohammad Abu Shabab during air strikes on Beit Hanun. Palestinian Attack: On the afternoon of June 18th 2012, Palestinian Gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line. At 04:20, Palestinian Gunmen launched 4 projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Attack: On the evening of June 18th 2012, Israeli forces fired artillery shells from their positions behind the Green Line towards Gaza.

CENTRAL GAZA	 Attack: On the evening of June 18th2012, Israeli forces fired artillery shells from their positions behind the Green line towards Al-Bureij Camp. Arial Assault: At 23:20, Israeli aircrafts launched missiles towards the border fence near Deir Al-Balah and killed 2 Palestinian gunmen. Killing: Israeli forces killed Mohammad Abu Mu'liq and Yusef Al-Talibani during airstrikes on Deir Al-Balah. 			
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, 18 truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed, 31 imported vehicles, fuel supplies and construction material for internationally funded projects.
