JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeded the free flow of traffic. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Bier Nabala. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on June 18th 2013, Israeli forces raided Al-Eizariya and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on June 18th 2013, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Najib and

	<p>Adli Najib in the old city of Jerusalem.</p> <p>(ii) Israeli forces detained Samer Thaher in Al-Eizariya.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Property:</u> On June 17th 2013, Israeli authorities announced plans for the construction of Water Well in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem on land occupied in 1967 and gave its residents 60 days to dispute the decision. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.
<p style="text-align: center;">RAMALLAH & AL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Atara bridge. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:00 on June 18th 2013 and again at 03:45 on June 19th 2013, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Mash'al village and detained 4 residents. (ii) At 12:35, Israeli forces raided Sinjil and Jilijliya village until 15:25. (iii) At 07:35, Israeli forces raided Ramallah until 08:00. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 residents: Mu'tasim Rabi', Othman Zahran, Ayed Atta and Mohammad Taha in Deir Abu Mash'al village. • <u>Land Confiscation:</u> On June 12th 2013, Israeli forces served an order for the confiscation of 14 acres (dunumes) of land in Safa village and gave a 45 days' notice for residents to remove all items including agricultural trees planted on the land with in a period of 45 days in order to confiscate it for allegedly being "State owned land". • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
<p style="text-align: center;">JENIN</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jaba' junction. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, Israeli forces raided Jaba'. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Deir Abu Da'if village until 12:20. (iii) At 12:20 and again at 01:25, Israeli forces raided Jenin, clashed with its residents as they stormed 4 homes and several merchant shops in the industrial zone as well as destroying 10 entrance doors and detained a resident. (iv) At dawn on June 19th 2013, Israeli forces raided Arraba, stormed and searched 2 homes, temporarily detained its residents and released them after questioning. (v) At dawn on June 19th 2013, Israeli forces raided Annin village and detained a resident after storming and searching a home.

(ii) Israeli forces detained Mu'taz Abu Aliya in Jenin. (iii) Israeli forces detained Ali Yassin in Annin village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 18:45, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jammala checkpoint near the Green Line in Jenin and opened fire and fired stun grenades as they allegedly conducted military training. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TUBAS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army increased its restrictions on Palestinian access to the Northern Jordan Valley through the Tayasir checkpoint and prevented residents from entering the area.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv: checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic, temporarily detained several residents and released them after questioning. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 07:40 on June 18th 2013, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint Jabara village junction which is located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Qalqiliya. (ii) At 11:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Quffin village until 14:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:15, Israeli forces raided Baqat Al-Sharqiya, stormed a home then withdrew at 09:30. (ii) At 09:20, Israeli forces raided Allar until 10:05. (iii) At 12:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Masqufa village located in North Tulkarem. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 10:30, a demonstration took place in front of the International Red Cross Headquarters in Tulkarem in solidarity with Palestinian detainee and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.

(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Azzun. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, Israeli forces raided Jit village. (ii) At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Azzun

	<p>(iii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya, clashed with several residents and detained a high school student.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ali Al-Hatur in Qalqiliya. • <u>Attack:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at the north entrance of Azzun fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents: Mohammad Salim and Ahmad Salim. • <u>Obstruction of Education Sector:</u> At 12:00, Israeli forces demolished a 120 m High and 12 meter wide concrete wall surrounding a high school in Azzun Atma and Beit Amin for the purpose of confiscating it for the purpose of Wall construction. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 09:00, Israeli settlers stormed the entrance of Azzun, put up several leaflets at the entrance “Calling for all Israeli settlers to storm the entrance of the village” for protesting the alleged firebombing of an Israeli settler vehicle as it passed near the village entrance. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at ‘Azzun ‘Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of ‘Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 16:40, Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Yatma village. (ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up 3 checkpoints at the entrances of Aqraba, Talfit and Qusra villages. • <u>Raid:</u> At 16:35, Israeli forces raided Qabalan, set up a checkpoint at its entrance, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and several merchant shops and as a result injured several residents as they detained 4 residents. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained 4 resident: Issam Azzar, Ziyad Aqqr'a, Wassim Aqqr'a and Anntar Aqqr'a'. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> On the evening of June 18th 2013, Israeli settlers stormed Assira Al-Qibliya and set fire to a Security guard booth near a water tank station.

SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 13:40, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara Al-checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:30. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:35, Israeli forces raided Marda village, summoned 2 residents: Husam Suliman and Qutayba Samih to report to Israeli Intelligence for question. (ii) At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya and summoned Mu'taz Al-Khatib to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 19:10, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Kafr Al-Dik detained Hani Al-Dik for alleged stoning. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

(ii) At 18:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho. (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along road 90 near Al-Nuweil'ma village located at the north entrance of Jericho. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> On June 18th 2013, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Sufiyan Basa, Head of the village council of Al-Eizariya village in Jerusalem as he was returning from travels from Jordan and released him after serving him a summon to report to Israeli intelligence.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunums of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. . • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks. (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.

At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. • On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. • Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Central Gaza.

<p>NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Point:</u> Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
<p>GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
