## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound (In Commemoration with the 47 anniversary of Al-Naksa (Israeli occupation of the West Bank and Gaza).
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Flying Checkpoints:**
  - (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up several checkpoints around the old city of Jerusalem wall near Al-Amoud Gate, Al-Sahra Gate, Al-Absat Gate, and Duwar Ras Al-Amoud.
  - (ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Biddu and Hizma village.
  - (iii) At 19:00, Israeli forces set up 2 checkpoints at the entrances of Beit Duqqu and Beit Ijza villages.
  - (iv) At 04:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Ram until 04:30.
- **Raid:**
  - (i) At 02:50, Israeli forces raided Qalandiya, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured 3 residents including 1 critically injured with wounds to the head: Mustafa Islan (injured critically with head wounds), Abdallah Shihadeh and Mahmoud Shihadeh and assaulted and injured Ibrahim Dahbour (A National Security Force officer) as the stormed his home, detained 6 residents then withdrew at 05:00.
  - (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Biddu, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes, destroyed the main entrance door of Ahmad Zahrans home using explosives and detained 4 residents.
  - (iii) At 04:40, Israeli forces raided Qutna village, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes, detained a resident, assaulted and injured Ahmad Shamasneh after destroying his home entrance leaving him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 05:00.

Detainees Update

Israeli Military court sentenced Aliya Al-Sheikh Abbas , a resident of Jerusalem to 40 months in prison for allegedly attempting to stab an Israeli soldier near Shu'fat checkpoint on January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2012 and was serving a home detention since February 22<sup>nd</sup> 2012 during which she turned herself in to Israeli authorities on March 8<sup>th</sup> 2014
