JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On June 15th 2012, the Israeli army increased its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city entrance and the entrance to the Old City. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <p>Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</p>

(ii) On June 14th 2012, Israeli forces detained Eyad Sa'di, a resident of Jenin for allegedly not having a valid entry permit. (iii) On June 16th 2012, Israeli forces detained Ahmad Sa'di, a resident of Jenin for allegedly not having a valid entry permit. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma'ale Adumim.

(ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint beneath Ein Yabrud Bridge until 21:10. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continued in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:25, Israeli forces raided Bal'a, set up a checkpoint then withdrew at 12:35. (ii) At 20:55, Israeli forces raided Allar. (iii) At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Al-Shweikiya neighbourhood until 04:25. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: At 01:15, Israeli forces positioned at Eniv checkpoint detained Nabil Abu Khalil a resident of Atil. • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, undercutting access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for adjustment of the Wall route continued in the area surrounding Jubara village. According to an Israeli High Court decision, the new Wall route will be constructed west of the village.
QALQILYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of the town of Azzun (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second <i>Intifada</i>, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. • Flying Checkpoint: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fanduk village. (ii) At 13:50 and again at 22:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Jit village junction until 00:15. (iii) At 23:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the eastern entrance of Qalqilya. • Settler Violence: At 21:10, Israeli settlers stoned vehicles passing along the main road connecting Azzun and Al-Nabi Eliyas and as a result injured Moath Al-Aqra' while damaging his vehicle. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, using a metal detector. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Imanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma'ale Shomron settlement.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Till-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. • Flying Checkpoint: At 12:50 and again at 23:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Deir Sharaf village junction, temporarily detained Usayed Baraham a University student from Tulkarem until 00:30. • Raids: At 23:50, Israeli forces raided Nablus while protecting Israeli settlers as

	<p>they raided Josephes Tomb, clashed with residents then withdrew at 05:20.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Detention: As mentioned in the previous report, at 01:30 on June 20th 2012, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Kafi during their raid into Nablus. • Settler Violence: On June 18th 2012, Israeli settlers raided and levelled 60 dunums of agricultural land in Jalud and Jurish villages for the purpose of settlement expansion and installed mobile homes in the area.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) Since 14 November 2010, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian buses only. The entrance had been closed for seven years, and at 11:00, Israeli forces closed the entrance and impeded the free flow of traffic. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to restrict access at Za'tara checkpoint and impede the free flow of traffic. • Raid: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya until 00:40. (ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Salfit, detained 2 residents including a preventive security officer then withdrew at 05:30. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Milad Dahdul and Muhanad Al-Zir during their raid into Salfit. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continued in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.

In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.</p> <p>(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. • On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. • Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Gaza, North Gaza and Central Gaza. • Israeli force Aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching 9 missiles Gaza, North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah leaving 2 Palestinian gunmen killed and 10 residents injured including 2 children. • Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of North Gaza. • Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching 98 projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for humanitarian assistance, journalists and international access. • Attack: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On the evening of June 20th 2012, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line fired 3 artillery shells towards Palestinian gunmen near Jabalya (ii) At 21:00, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of Beit Lahiya and detained 6 fishermen and confiscated a fishing boat. • Detention: Israeli forces detained Mohammad Abu Warda, Hadi Sa'dallah, Na'am Al-Saqsaq, Mohammad Khalat, Hatem Abu Warda and Fadil Abu Warda off the shores of Beit Lahiya. • Aerial Assault: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 02:20 on June 20th 2012, Israeli aircrafts fired missiles towards Palestinian gunmen near Al-Sheikh Zayid town, leaving a resident injured and destroyed a school as well as 5 homes in the area.
