The ceasefire has been further renewed on 30 October 2011 at 22:00. On 14.12.2011, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against pass beyond the mark. Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Gaza, North Gaza and Central Gaza. Israeli force Aircrafts broke the cease fire agreement by launching 9 missiles Gaza, North Gaza, Central Gaza, Khan Yunis and Rafah leaving 2 Palestinian gunmen killed and 10 residents injured including 2 children. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishermen off the shores of North Gaza.
