WEST BANK

- On June 20th 2014, The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the (i) entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a (iii) hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

Closure of Main Roads:

- The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the (i) entrance to Jaba' village.
- The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to (ii) Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.

Attack:

JERUSALEM

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets; stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and confiscated several surveillance tapes from several merchants' shops near the checkpoint.
- (ii) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning, and at 18:00 clashed with several residents and as a result injured Sultan Tuam and suffocated Omar Tawam from tear gas inhalation leaving him hospitalised with contusions.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) At 01:00, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 09:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Arora.
- (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Arora and Mazare' Al-Nuba village.
- (iii) At 17:35 and again at 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Atara bridge located in north Bir Zeit until 21:30
- (iv) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp and near "Bet El "settlement until 05:00.

Raid: At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Ramallah and Al-Bireh cities, clashed with several residents as they stormed "Pal-Media" Journalist offices and "Nun "Institute for Islamic scholars and "Al-Ghad" broadcast radio and as a result injured 2 residents: Musa Ma'almeh and Mu'tasim Ahmad and confiscated several computers and broadcast equipment for Al-Aqsa Television then withdrew at 03:30.

• <u>Home Occupation:</u> At 15:30, Israeli forces stormed the area between Aroura and Abwein and occupied a home (Under construction) owned by Mu'hsin Al-Arouri and converted it into a military post.

• Attack:

- (i) At 18:20, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Silwad fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning
- (ii) At 21:35 Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Aroura fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.

• Settler Violence:

- (i) At 10:00, Israeli settlers positioned at "Halamish" settlement junction stoned residents and vehicles.
- (ii) At 23:00, Israeli settlers positioned at "Bet El" settlement junction stoned several residents and vehicles passing along the main road leading to Al-

- and they stormed several homes and as a result suffocated Mu'in Masahat from tear gas inhalation then stormed and searched an Islamic college and confiscated a computer then withdrew at 03:50.
- (ii) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Baqat Al-Hatab village, clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes.
- (iii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Hajja village and stormed and searched 4 homes.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 13:315 a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance, clashed with Israeli forces as they attempted to disrupt demonstrators and left several residents suffocating from tear gas inhalation.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.
- <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.

• Raid:

- (i) At 22:20, Israeli forces raided Nablus until 23:30.
- (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces raided Kafil Kalil and Burin village until 02:00.
- (iii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Nablus, Balata and Asqar camps, clashed with several residents as they stormed several homes and a Currency exchange store and confiscated a computer and several documents from the exchange store and injured 2 residents including a child: Mohammad Al-Asmar (17 years old) and Ahmad Al-Wazani, detained 3 residents then withdrew at 05:00.

(iv) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Bazariya village and stormed and searched a home.

- (v) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Assirah Al-Shimaliya, stormed and searched 2 homes then withdrew at 05:50.
- (vi) At 02:25, Israeli forces raided Tel village, stormed and searched 11 homes (including several homes of Palestinian Intelligence officers) then withdrew at 05:50.
- (vii)At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Salem village and stormed and searched a home.
- **<u>Detention:</u>** Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Anas Al-Qutub, Wael Al-Amoudi and Ahamd Tam in Balata and Asqar camps in Nablus.

NABLUS

Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to tw9 (i) detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city (ii) to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to (iii) Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: Israeli forces closed Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. Raid: (i) At 14:10, Israeli forces raided Marda village until 14:50. (ii) At 19:25, Israeli force raided Deir Ballut until 20:30. (iii) At 20:45, Israeli force raided Khirbeit Qays village until 22:30. **SALFIT** (iv) At 01:30, Israeli forces raided Harris village, stormed and searched Abu Bakr Al-Sadig mosque, a reception hall and several homes and as a result killed a resident after he suffered a heart attack as Israeli forces stormed his home and prevented medical unites from reaching him and also assaulted and injured 2 residents: Jawdat Daoud and Awad Daoud (broken arm) then withdrew at 05:20. (v) At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Iskaka village, searched a home then withdrew at 03:50. (vi) At 03:15, Israeli forces raided Farkhat village, stormed and searched 2 homes and a beauty Salon shop and confiscated several documents then withdrew at 04:10. Killing: Israeli forces caused the death of Jamil Suf (60 years old) after suffering a heart attack as Israeli forces stormed his home then prevented medical unites from reaching the area. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement. **Closure:** At 19:40, Israeli forces declared the Dead Sea area as a closed Military area { After announcing that 3 Israeli Settlers went missing in the Hebron area} **Checkpoints:** Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 18:30. Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Oja village junction until **JERICHO** (ii) At 23:00, Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fasayil village until 01:00. Raid: At 22:40, Israeli forces raided Fasayil village, stormed and searched several homes and "Maen Educational Institution" and detained 3 resident then withdrew **Detention:** Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Faris Zien Al-Din, Maoayad Zien Al-Din and Ahmad Zien Al-Din in Fasayil village. **Closure:** (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the **BETHLEHEM** exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from (ii) accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- (ix) At 10:40 on June 19th 2014, Israeli forces closed the north entrance of Beit Jallah with steal gates.
- <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:55, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Container checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 14:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near "Kafr Etsiyon" settlement junction located along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron until 15:05.
- (ii) At 14:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the West entrance of Beit Fajjar until 15:05.
- (iii)At 15:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the north entrance of Beit Jallah until 17:15.
- (iv)At 17:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem.

• Raid:

- (i) At 12:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Obidiya until 13:00.
- (ii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Dar Salah village until 19:20.
- (iii)At 22:00, Israeli force raided Bethlehem, stormed and searched several homes and again at 00:30 and stormed and searched An Orphanage and confiscated several computers then withdrew at 02:40.
- (iv) At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Beit Jallah until 02:30.
- (v) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Taqou', stormed several homes and detained 17 residents.
- (vi)At 02:40, Israeli forces Abu Najim village, stormed and searched several homes and detained 2 residents.

• Detention:

- (i) Israeli forces detained 17 residents: Jamil Jabril, Kamal Al-Badan, Assad Al-Badan, Mohammad Sabah, Khaled Al-Badan, Sami Al-Badan, Sharif Al-Badan, Amir Al-Badan, Samih Al-Sabah, Saud Al-Badan, Ayman Jabril, Mohammad Kawazba, Akram Jabril Ibrahim Salahat, Sabri Jabril, Bassam Al-Badan and Samir Al-Amour in Taqou'.
- (ii) Israeli forces detained 2 residents: Wael Salahat and Ibrahim Salahat in Abu Najim village.
- Attack: At 19:30 and again at 02:00, Israeli forces positioned at near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several resident for alleged stoning.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 13:35, a demonstration took place in Al-Ma'sara village protesting against the construction of the wall during which Israeli forces prevented protesters from reaching the demonstration site.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May 1st 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- (x) At 08:00 on June 15th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the North entrance of

Hebron.

(xi) At 19:30 on June 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Beit Einun village with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoints:

- (i) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Yunis area located along the main road connecting Bethlehem and Hebron.
- (ii) At 09:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Huwar area located at the north entrance of Halhul.
- (iii)At 17:50 Israeli force set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fuwar camp.

• <u>Raid:</u>

- (i) At 11:00, Israeli forces raided Yatta, detained a resident after storming and searching his home and gain at 02:35, detained another resident
- (ii) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided the area in east Halhul and clashed with residents as they stormed several homes.
- (iii)At 13:10, Israeli forces with Helicopter support overhead raided Fuqin area located between Hebron and Tarqumiya, set up a checkpoint and occupied a home owned by Shartit family and converted it into a military post.
- (iv)At 14:30, Israeli forces raided Hebron, stormed and searched several homes, merchant shops and an Athletic club after destroying its main entrance gate and again at 02:30, stormed and searched several homes, merchant shops and an Islamic charity and detained 2 children.

- (vi)At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Tarqumiya and detained a resident after storming his home.
- (vii)At 02:00, Israeli forces raided Ithna and detained a resident after storming his home.
- (viii) At 02:30, Israeli forces raided Halhuol and stormed and searched an Islamic Charity Organization.
- (ix)At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Sa'ir. and stormed and searched an Islamic Charity Organization and the Palestinian Red Crescent and confiscated a computer.
